

#### **Faith Formation**

### Gospel Reflection

Last weekend we began listening to Jesus' **Sermon on the Mount,** which will continue until the first Sunday of Lent, February 26. We heard the familiar passage on the **Beatitudes**. This weekend Jesus continues with some strong words on the **Law**. He starts with a disclaimer: "...I have not come to abolish the law...but to fulfill." He then encourages his followers to be faithful to the law with such fervor that their "righteousness" would surpass that of the religious leaders. What a challenge! In this part of his sermon, Jesus covers many different aspects of the law: ...giving scandal, murder, divorce, adultery, taking false oaths...

His strong exhortation on fidelity to the law is interesting given his own mixed relationship with some parts of it. Remember how he angered the Pharisees when he healed people on the Sabbath? Or how he and his disciples were criticized because they didn't fast as often as the law prescribed.

Now ponder carefully what Jesus goes on to say about these particular precepts. In each case, Jesus offers a caveat, a "yes, but consider this."

**Killing** is against the law, but also harmful is **being angry** with your "brother." Jesus says, **do something** about that broken relationship before you come to "offer your gift at the altar."

**Divorce** is allowed as long as a man gives a simple "bill of divorce" to his wife, often leaving her without material support. Jesus takes exception to this law, perhaps because of its **unjust treatment of women.** 

**Adultery** is wrong, but Jesus says, so is lusting after another in your heart.

Clearly, Jesus is asking his followers to look deeper into each mandate. To reflect on questionable motivations, behaviors, impact on others. Simply obeying the letter of the law is not enough. Conversion of heart must be a motivating force at work in everyone.

What can we 21st century Christians take away from this sermon preached so long ago, in such a different cultural and religious context? We need to hear it while also keeping Jesus' other words and actions in mind, remembering also that his strongest and most consistent message was about loving God and loving your neighbor. How? By caring for the least among us, for that is how we will be judged in the end. Matthew 25 makes it very clear:

"As long as you did it for the least of these, you did it for me..." Matt. 25

Devotion to The Holy Face of Jesus started in 1844 with an apparition of Our Lord to a Carmelite nun. Following an investigation by the Church, Pope Leo XIII approved it in 1885. Since then, several Popes endorsed it.

The Holy Face of Jesus novena (to obtain special graces or make special petitions) is most often prayed during the nine days leading up to the Feast of the Holy Face on Shrove Tuesday, the day before Ash Wednesday. The novena begins this year on Sunday February 12.


