Faith Formation

Gospel Reflection

"You shall not bear hatred for your brother or sister in your heart." *Leviticus 19*

"...love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you." *Matt. 5*

From the Sermon on the Mount, a Difficult Challenge

In just three days we will be signed with **ashes** and our Lenten journey will begin. Today's Scriptures provide an appropriate and challenging send-off as our church launches us into that holy season. Take some moments to reflect on just a few of the events of the past two years:...contested election, January 6 storming of the Capitol, mass shootings at schools and public places, death threats and physical attacks against public officials, disputes with school boards over library books and courses, violence against Jewish synagogues, African Americans, Asians, Hispanics...to name just a few.

Given that history, we are faced with today's Scriptures. The gospel is especially troubling. Is Jesus really telling us to allow ourselves to be mistreated by others without offering any resistance? Is he really asking us to **love our enemies**? Here's where a bit of Scripture scholarship comes in handy. According to one scholar, this passage is "one of the most dangerously misinterpreted teachings" in the New Testament. In some of the examples in today's Gospel (turning the other cheek, offering no resistance to one who is evil, going the extra mile), Jesus offers creative ways to respond to oppressors without treating them in kind. And the people of his time understood. Examples: After being struck on the right cheek, turn the other. In their right-handed culture, they knew that a back-handed slap would not be able to land where it should. Another example: Roman soldiers could only force foreigners to carry their pack one mile and no more or they would incur disciplinary action. Jesus' suggestion to go the extra mile would put the abuser in jeopardy. So Jesus proposes **non violent** ways for his followers to respond to mistreatment. **Did not the peacemakers of our time do the same?**

Thomas Merton **preached peace and justice from a Trappist monastery** through the power of the pen. Martin Luther King Jr. responded to violence with **the power of his preaching** and the witness of non-violent marches. And now, in 2023, on the doorstep of Lent, we ask ourselves: how will we respond to hateful words and actions that might erupt in our local communities? How can we as a parish community or as individuals search for creative ways to **challenge injustice, respond to prejudice, engage adversaries with respect?** In short, **love our enemies?** The season of Lent beckons us to practice what Jesus preached.

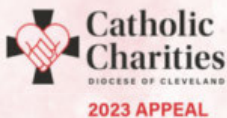

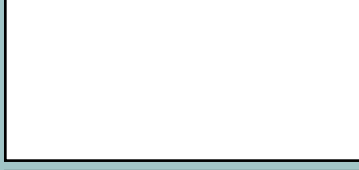

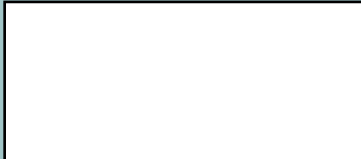
