



Gospel Reflection

The time is here.

The holy time when we are called to enter into the desert. When we are called to pray, to fast, and to give alms. What kind of Lent will it be for us this year? Events around the world and in our country could shape our response.

The time is here to pray.

To pray in solidarity with those who are grieving over the bodies of loved ones; loved ones lost to earthquakes, war, floods, hunger, disease, gun violence, police brutality, gang warfare, suicide. **Let us pray** daily, in the quiet of our room, in the comfort of the church, or during our daily tasks. In silence for once, allowing God to speak, cutting through the babble of our world.

The time is here to fast.

To fast in solidarity with those who know the daily pangs of hunger, who are forced to fast because there is no food. Let us also consider fasting from selfish pursuits, from judgmental words and actions, from hours spent on meaningless social media. May our fasting help transform ourselves and our own small corner of the world.

The time is here for giving alms.

To share what we have with those who have not, remembering that **giving alms** doesn't always have to be about money. Our almsgiving can also be the **gift of our time.** Perhaps now is the time to search out all the outreach programs in our city and in our parish and ask ourselves: where are we most needed now, offering our gift of time?

Like Jesus in today's gospel, who was tempted to abandon the ministry that lay before him, let us resist the voices that will whisper in our ears:

"You are too busy."

"You are not comfortable with visiting sick people."

"You don't need to pray every morning."

"You shouldn't get involved in social justice issues, like gun violence or racial disparities."

With Jesus, let us say to the voices - "Begone, Satan."

The time is here. May it find us ready.

given to the Akron Ronald McDonald House. Cookies can also be preordered and picked up that weekend.




