

Reflecting on the scriptures

"Many of his disciples returned to their former way of life and no longer accompanied him. "

In today's gospel we see the cost of the good news. The way of life that Jesus preached and modeled asked too much for some of his hearers.

Forgive others as God has forgiven you? Turn the other cheek? Blessed are the meek and the peacemakers and those who hunger and thirst for justice? For some of his disciples this was all too hard. And this most recent invitation to share his very life, his body and blood, was a deal-breaker.

We face the same challenge today. In a world where loud voices tell us that getting as much money and keeping as much power as possible are appropriate goals for life, Christian living is for suckers and losers.

<u>Special Collection next weekend—August 31 & September 1</u> Help us *Build the Future* for the Children of St. Hilary School of the Congo!

On the weekend of August 31 and September 1, we will again ask for your support with the Building the Future program in the Congo. The collection will help with the ongoing effort for education for the children and to provide the necessary machinery to help build a better life for the adults and their children.

In September of 2020, St. Hilary Parish and School began working with Gaspard Nzita from the Democratic Republic of the Congo to build a sister school—St. Hilary School of the Congo, in the territory of Tshala. Over the past four years the school has been built and many additions have been added to facilitate the teaching of carpentry, building, sewing, grinding and building the machinery that aids in the making of bricks, flour, oil, soap, etc. With your donations



last year, computers with screens were purchased and 18,000 videos have been set up in French to teach the children from kindergarten, high school and into the university levels. With your generous donations, we also were able to begin the building of a much needed hospital/clinic that is a mile from the school. St. Hilary School of the Congo is now the center of education and the connection of the schools in eight sectors in Tshela.

Gaspard tells us that God has promoted this vision and the seed of love and kindness has been planted by our parish. St. Hilary is changing lives! You are brining local communities together and helping the people of Tshela to start their own businesses and provide for their families.

■Kindergarten 2024-2025 Opening Schedule WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 28 – HALF DAY

- First day of school for Kindergarteners only. To help children acclimate, this will be a HALF DAY.
- ON AUGUST 28 ONLY, Kindergarten students will arrive between 8:30 and 8:45 am, after our regular drop-off time. This will allow time for saying goodbyes in our "hug zone" outside our main entrance before our Kindergarten team takes children to classrooms. Look for your child's teacher and teaching assistants holding signs indicating where each class should meet near the main entrance / Jesus statue.
- If your Kindergartener will ride the bus to school during the first week of school, please email his/her teacher so arrangements can be made to assist your child in getting to the classroom.
- ALL kindergarten students will attend from 8:45 a.m. to 12:00 pm. There will be no buses to take kindergarten students home on these days and no Latchkey available for kindergarten students these afternoons. Please be sure your child has a ride home.

ON AUGUST 28 ONLY, Rooms 101 and 104 will be dismissed from the Moorfield Road doors. Room 105 will be dismissed from the doors by the Jesus statue. The child's name should be displayed prominently in the passenger window. Please email the teacher if someone other than a parent will be picking up your child.




