



## **Faith Formation**

## Gospel Reflection

Pity the priest who has to preach on today's gospel; it tempts us to take sides and that is a losing proposition. We know the story. Jesus comes to visit his friends at Bethany. Martha is busy in the kitchen with the tasks of hospitality. Her sister, Mary, however, has chosen to sit and listen to Jesus in the other room. Martha asks Jesus to send Mary to the kitchen to help. And Jesus, instead, supports Mary's decision. So at this point in the story, how do you feel about Martha? About Mary? In fact, how do you feel about Jesus?

First let's remember a couple of things. The Jews put great emphasis on hospitality. Jesus was not belittling Martha's work. Also, though Jesus had men and women disciples, theological study in the synagogue was reserved for men. Jesus' inclusion of women among his "students" was exceptional. So instead of choosing between Martha and Mary, I suggest we take a look at the difference between "doing" and "being."


For many years the family all gathered at our house on Christmas Eve for a gift exchange and meal. Though everyone contributed to the buffet, still I was the hostess. And the Martha in me was given full reign! I hovered at the buffet. Do we need more chicken wings? How is the dip holding up on the veggie tray? And on and on! At the end of the evening I had the satisfaction of knowing everyone had been well fed and given their presents. But what about presence? I had not had a significant conversation with anyone.

By the time Covid hit, the family had grown to include quite a crew! Clearly, having twenty people packed into our living room was ill-advised. So, instead, the family took turns over the holiday coming in small groups. A son and daughter-in-law, empty-nesters, stopped for a glass of wine and cheese and crackers one evening. A grandson with his newly minted driver's license drove his sister over for hot cocoa and Christmas cookies and I learned so much about their young lives. A daughter and her family, game players all, came for snacks and a rousing afternoon of Christmas trivia games.

This was presence. Being instead of doing. Our culture prizes doing, accomplishing tasks. And certainly work needs to be done. But Zoom is not the same thing as sitting across from another person and social media is even less intimate.

## St, Hilary seeking full time custodial/ maintenance worker

St. Hilary Parish and School is currently seeking a full time custodial/maintenance worker to join our Maintenance Department. The ideal candidate is positive, reliable, and capable of maintaining an attractive, sanitary and safe facility for students, staff and public. Demonstrates strong work ethic and possess effective written and verbal communication skills. Lastly, the ability to work well with others and independently. Performance responsibilities include, but not limited to; vacuuming, mopping, shampoo/ spot clean carpets and furniture, washing windows; Removes trash in accordance with established procedures; Cleans and disinfects restrooms, locker rooms, cafeteria, classrooms and hallways; Operate power equipment such as carpet cleaner, pressure washer, hand and power tools; Distributes supplies, equipment (e.g. fill soap dispensers, towel/toilet paper dispensers, packages, and furniture) for the purpose of distributing materials to appropriate parties and/or locations; Providing assistance and information to those who use the facilities; Secures facilities and grounds, depending on shift. (e.g. local doors, turn off lights, set alarms, etc.) Set up and tear down for different events during school, in the evenings, and on weekends. Each custodial has a scheduled work time. When school is closed for a calamity day or for summer, hours may be more flexible; performs other duties as assigned. A background check is required and will be completed if/when hired. # What's Happening with the Citizens Bank Building?

Dear Parishioners, I want to give you a little update on the Citizens Bank Building, our neighbor to the West. As many of you know, the Citizens Bank has moved further west to the site of the former Core Life restaurant. The building at 2770 West Market Street is now totally vacant. The property which includes the building and ALL OF THE PARKING to the west of our church building is now potentially for lease to another entity. We have been in touch with the owner to express our interest in the property so as to preserve our ability to use it for church parking. The owner, which is a Real Estate Investment Company headquartered in San Diego California, is not interested in selling the property to anyone at this time due to a provision to protect investors in the REIT from any Capital Gains liability, and will therefore pursue a new lessee. We do not know how attractive the present building is to developers, and we suspect that any future deal will take time to materialize.

Having said that, the St Hilary Finance Council will continue to stay informed of future developments and will also continue to let the owner know of our interest in the property.

Families will be given a CGS handbook at our initial meeting (October 2 at 9:00 am), including a complete calendar.

The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) Program is a Montessori based Catholic religious education program which nurtures the child's relationship with God, and educates the child in the faith. Dr. Maria Montessori's approach follows St. Thomas Aquinas' understanding that "all our knowledge has its origin in the senses." The "Atrium" is a place of prayer, prepared especially for children to contemplate the life of Jesus and the liturgy of the Church with the use of many sensorial materials, including infancy narrative figures, a raised surface map of the Land of Israel, and a model altar. This concrete method of presenting the faith is similar to the way the Church teaches us.






