



#### FR. MATT'S LETTER

Today we enter the "ordinary" Sundays with the Baptism of the Lord. Our second reading speaks about the "generous love of God." We see that generosity in Jesus acceptance of baptism. As Pope emeritus Benedict observed: "The act of descending into the waters of this Baptism implies a confession of guilt and a plea for forgiveness in order to make a new beginning."\*

Those baptized by John confess their sins and seek to rid themselves of their burden of guilt. But, asked Pope Benedict, "What did Jesus do in this same situation?" Jesus obviously had no need of repentance. He contains "all righteousness." In today's Gospel, the Father says to Jesus, "You are my beloved son; with you I am well pleased." By accepting baptism, Jesus shows the generous love of God. Again, let me quote the retired Pope,

"Looking at the events in light of the Cross and Resurrection, the Christian people realized what happened: Jesus loaded the burden of all mankind's guilt upon his shoulders, he bore it down into the depths of the Jordan. He is, as it were, the true Jonah who said to the crew of the ship, 'Take me and throw me into the sea.""

By our baptism into Christ, we receive the generous love of God. Our baptism, however, even if it took place when we were infants, is not meant to be only a passive reception. By taking our guilt and sins upon himself, Jesus is calling us to live the generous love of God.

What a profound gift we have received in Baptism. We have become Children of God by spiritual adoption.

CEMETERY DUES FOR ALL PARISHIONERS IN THE MARI-**ON CATHOLIC COMMUNITY**—Cemetery dues will be collected in the months of January and February. Dues are \$10.00 per single person who is 21 or older or \$20.00 for married couples and families. You are NOT reserving a cemetery plot, but simply maintaining the cemetery. The cost for a cemetery plot for anyone who has not paid his/her dues is \$1,000.00 per lot for single persons or \$2,000.00 for married couples and families. If you are a member of a parish, you are to pay cemetery dues. There is an envelope in your mailed packet or you can use a plain envelope marked cemetery dues with your name and parish on it and drop it in the collection at Mass. Also, if you have paid dues, there is still a fee for purchasing a cemetery lot. Please contact the parish office or the head of the cemetery of your parish, if you have any questions. 
