




"GETTING TO KNOW THE FAMILY"

As the youngest of 6 children (5 boys and 1 girl), I was born in 1951 in Tiffin, Ohio, and shared my youthful gifts with others as a Mass Server, as a member of the Children's Choir, by mowing lawns for a few neighbors, and by carrying newspapers for the route the Alt boys handled for many years. In 1965, thoughts about a vocation to the priesthood led me to Brunnerdale High School Seminary, followed by St. Joseph's College in Rensselaer, Indiana in 1969, and eventually to Mount St. Mary's Seminary of the West, Cincinnati, in 1974. I was ordained to the priesthood with the Missionaries of the Precious Blood in 1978.

Generally speaking, my priestly ministry has been carried out in various parishes in Ohio and Indiana, with some special ministry appointments as Vocation Director, and as the Director of Spiritual Formation on behalf of C.PP.S. candidates for the priesthood/ brotherhood at St. Joseph's College for a number of years, when I was a fairly young priest. I came to Mercer County in 1999 to work with one of the first clusters of 3 parishes (St. Anthony, St. Peter, & St. Joseph, Fort Recovery.) Parish work is my "cup of tea", but I have never really enjoyed or found fulfillment in the administrative duties, which come with being a pastor.


I choose to embrace a fairly humble or simple kind of life, which

includes regular walks through the neighborhood, working with jigsaw puzzles, creative cooking (soups, casseroles, etc.), and time for prayer, reading, or relaxation (and naps!) on the front porch. 


