My Dear People,

In the Gospel today, we hear the story of the multiplication of the loaves and fish. From some meager offerings, Jesus is able to feed all those who are present. We bring to Mass the little that we have, all the fragments of our inadequacies, our successes and failures, our hopes and fears. We offer them to God with the fruits of the earth and the work of human hands, and these small gifts are transformed and offered back to us as the gift of Jesus' sacramental Body and Blood, in whose life we are gathered. So bring your needs, burdens and petitions to prayer when you are at Mass and ask that God grant what you need in His time and according to His will.

We continue to make progress on our campus improvement projects: The Columbarium and Connector path project is scheduled to be completed in late August or early September; we are receiving delivery of new niches in the next few days and the connector path will be paved in the next few weeks. The Solar installation project on the Gym roof has been completed, and we are awaiting commissioning and the rebate from Duke to close it out. Duke Power has scheduled the installation of the driveway lights on the South Campus driveway for this month, and it should be completed before school starts again next month.

I will be away from the parish on vacation from July 30 through August 6. I am looking forward to some time away for rest and renewal.

Estaré fuera de la parroquia de vacaciones del 30 de julio al 6 de agosto. Estoy a la espera de este tiempo para descansar y renovarme.

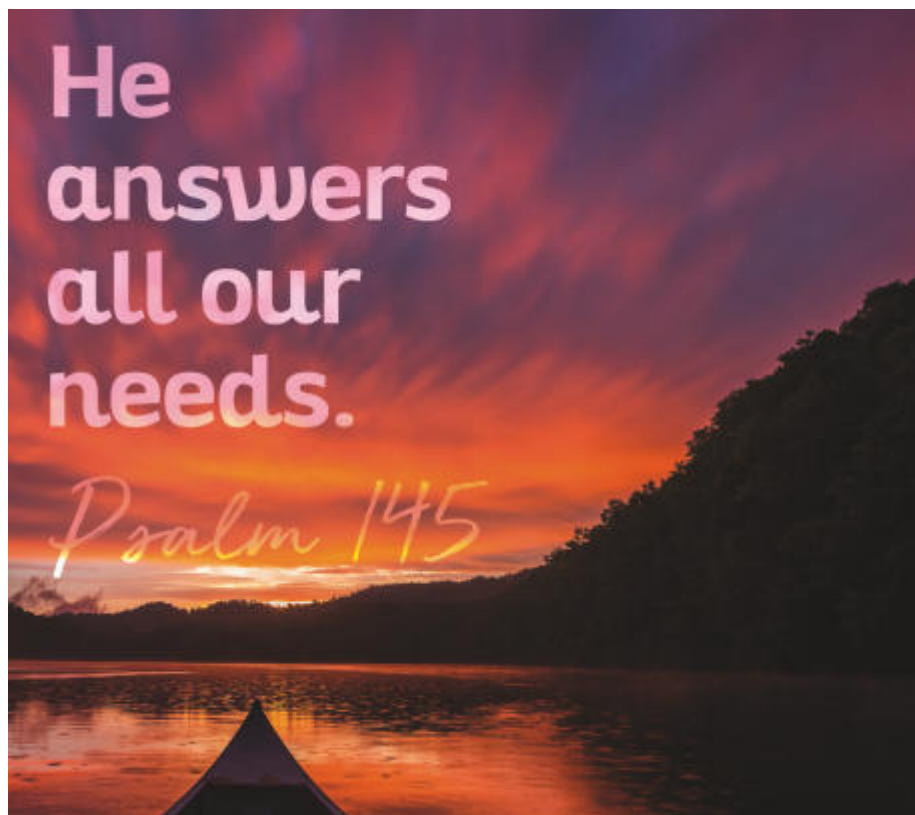

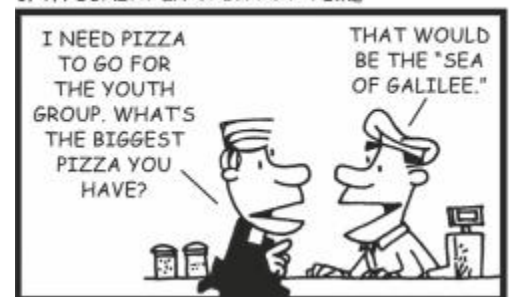
SECOND READING

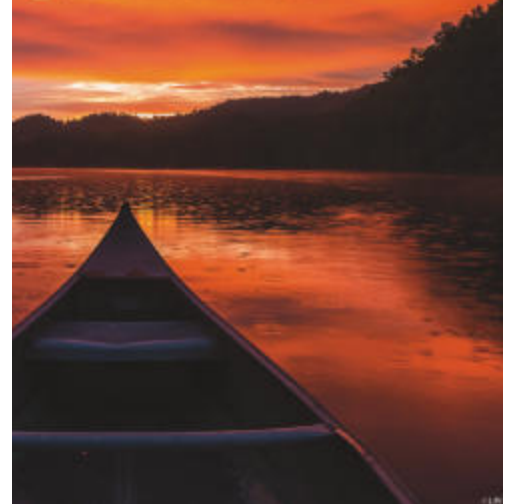
