A NOTE FROM FR. SCOTT | UNA NOTA DEL PADRE SCOTT

My Dear People,

I hope you had a very merry and blessed Christmas day. A special welcome to anyone who is visiting us for the holiday.

We are now in the Octave of Christmas. Octave means an eight-day celebration, that is, the prolongation of a feast to the eighth day (*dies octava*) inclusive. The feast itself is considered the first day, and it is followed by six days called "days within the octave." The eighth or octave day is kept with greater solemnity than the "days within the octave." (With Christ Through the Year, Bernard Strasser) We began the Octave with Christmas, and we will conclude on January 1, the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God.

One of the feasts within the Octave is today, the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. The family has been called the "domestic church," as it is the first encounter children have with the Gospel, and it is the dwelling place of faith and the lived experience of Christian relationships. This does not mean that it is place of perfection, though. We can all attest to this from the experience of our own family life. We see today even the Holy Family having their share of challenges as Mary and Joseph search for Jesus, thinking he was with the caravan but he had actually stayed in the temple. Joseph and Mary dealt with parenting a preteen who thought he was fine on his own. Maybe you can relate. The Holy Family had real life challenges. Perfection in family life is not possible, but holiness is. This holiness comes through families who practice love, concern, forgiveness, and care for one another.

As noted above, January 1 is the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. A vigil Mass will be celebrated on Friday at 5:15PM in English and at 7:00PM in Spanish. On Saturday morning, Mass will be celebrated at 9:30AM in English. All Masses will be in the church. January 1 is also the World Day of Prayer for Peace. In 1968, Pope Paul VI said "The world must be educated to love Peace, to build it up and defend it." In the wake of so many recently senseless violent acts, it is good and fitting that we come together on January 1 to implore for the gift of peace upon our communities, our nation, and our world.

Queridos Todos,

Espero que hayan tenido un día de Navidad muy feliz y bendecido. Una bienvenida especial a cualquiera que nos visita por vacaciones.

Ahora estamos en la Octava de Navidad. Octava significa una celebración de ocho días, es decir, la prolongación de una fiesta hasta el octavo día (*dies octava*) inclusive. La fiesta en sí se considera el primer día, y es seguida por seis días llamados "días dentro de la octava". El octavo día u octava se mantiene con mayor solemnidad que los "días dentro de la octava". (Con Cristo a través del año, Bernard Strasser.) Comenzamos la Octava con La Navidad, y concluiremos el 1 de enero, solemnidad de María, Madre de Dios.



Una de las fiestas dentro de la Octava es hoy, la Sagrada Familia de Jesús, María y José. La familia ha sido llamada la "iglesia doméstica", ya que es el primer encuentro que los niños tienen con el Evangelio, y es la morada de la fe y la experiencia vivida de las relaciones cristianas. Sin embargo, esto no significa que sea un lugar de perfección. Todos podemos dar fe de ello a partir de la experiencia de nuestra propia vida familiar. Hoy vemos que incluso la

Sagrada Familia tiene su parte de desafíos mientras María y José buscan a Jesús, pensando que él estaba con la caravana, pero en realidad se había quedado en el templo. José y María se ocuparon de criar a un preadolescente que pensaba que estaba bien por sí solo. Tal vez puedan identificarse. La Sagrada Familia tenía desafíos de la vida real. La perfección en la vida familiar no es posible, pero la santidad sí. Esta santidad viene a través de familias que practican el amor, la preocupación, el perdón y el cuidado mutuo.

Como se señaló anteriormente, el 1 de enero es la solemnidad de María, Madre de Dios. Se celebrará una misa de vigilia el viernes a las 5:15PM en inglés y a las 7:00PM en español. El sábado por la mañana, la misa se celebrará a las 9:30AM en inglés. Todas las misas serán en la iglesia. El 1 de enero es también la Jornada Mundial de Oración por la Paz. En 1968, el Papa Pablo VI dijo: "El mundo debe ser educado para amar la Paz, para construirla y defenderla". A raíz de tantos actos violentos recientemente sin sentido, es bueno y apropiado que nos reunamos el 1 de enero para implorar por el regalo de la paz sobre nuestras comunidades, nuestra nación y nuestro mundo.
