A NOTE FROM FR. SCOTT | UNA NOTA DEL PADRE SCOTT

My Dear People,

We hear in the Gospel the story of Jesus' first public miracle at the Wedding Feast at Cana. Key to this dramatic act is his mother, Mary. She is present as Jesus begins His public ministry, and she will be there at the foot of the cross as Jesus dies. Notice here in the Gospel of John that Mary is not named. The evangelist simply says that "the mother of Jesus was there." At the cross, she will be nameless as well along with the Beloved Disciple. For John, the emphasis is always on Jesus. A good lesson for us. Our focus must always be on Christ and His true identity. It is so easy to be drawn away from Him and look to other curiosities or novelties. But in this Gospel of John, we will see many signs that reveal Jesus' identity as the Son of God, the Word made flesh. The focus must always be on Christ. For in Him, we find our true identity.

This coming Saturday, 90 children from our parish will celebrate the sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time in preparation for their First Holy Communion in the Spring. I extend my thanks to our Faith Development Catechists and school teachers who have been preparing our children to receive this sacrament of God's mercy and love.

I want to inform you of an upcoming change on our parish staff. Maureen Earnhardt, Director of Elementary Faith Development, will be stepping down from her position at the conclusion of Vacation Bible School this summer. After serving well in this position and running an outstanding EFD program, Maureen has decided that the time is right for her to pass the reigns to someone else. I am grateful to Maureen for her many years of service to this parish community and especially her work in leading our Elementary program. We are in the process of beginning the search for Maureen's replacement, who I hope to have in place this summer.

We have also restarted the search for the Director of Adult Faith Development and Catechumenate. Your generous response to our increased offertory appeal has made it possible for us to secure the necessary funding for this position. It is also my hope that this person will be in place over the summer.

This week we are mindful of the anniversary of the Supreme Court decision of Roe v. Wade, which legalized abortion in the United States. As a Church, we continue to stand up for the cause for human life and defend and protect it at all stages. In *Evangelium Vitae*, Pope St. John Paul II wrote: "We are facing an enormous and dramatic clash between good and evil, death and life, the 'culture of death' and the 'culture of life.'" We find ourselves not only faced with but necessarily in the midst of this conflict: we are all involved and we all share in it, with the inescapable responsibility of choosing to be unconditionally pro-life." As Catholics, we are called to be heralds of the Gospel of Life. I am grateful to our Respect Life Committee for their continued good work. You can find a variety of pamphlets in both English and Spanish concerning life issues in the alcove opposite of Friends and Family Hall.



En *Evangelium Vitae*, el Papa San Juan Pablo II escribió: "Estamos ante un enorme y dramático choque entre el bien y el mal, la muerte y la vida, la 'cultura de la muerte' y la 'cultura de la vida'". Nos encontramos no solo frente a este conflicto, sino necesariamente en medio de él: todos estamos involucrados y todos compartimos en él, con la responsabilidad ineludible de elegir ser incondicionalmente pro-vida". Como católicos, estamos llamados a ser heraldos del Evangelio de la Vida. Estoy agradecido a nuestro Comité de Respeto a la Vida por su buen trabajo continuo. Puede encontrar una variedad de folletos en inglés y español sobre temas de la vida en la sala frente al Salón de Amigos y Familiares.

The prophet Isaiah used marriage imagery (bridge and groom) to describe the Lord's love for his people, Israel. What do you see as some implications of this marriage imagery?


SECOND READING



SÍNODO 2021-2023 EN LA DIÓCESIS DE RALEIGH

¿Qué está pasando en la diócesis?

En respuesta al llamado del Santo Padre Papa Francisco, el obispo Luis Rafael Zarama ha abierto un proceso de escucha diocesana.
