A NOTE FROM FR. SCOTT | UNA NOTA DEL PADRE SCOTT

My Dear People,

Today in the Gospel, we hear the passage of Jesus returning to his hometown and going to the synagogue. He gives the scroll of the Prophet Isaiah and reads the passage where Isaiah says: "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, and to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord." Jesus read this passage with authority and in such a way that everyone was looking at him as he sat down. As he did, he said, "Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing." Jesus would be the one to do all of those things that Isaiah prophesied. Notice, too, that all that Jesus talks about has to do with action in the world. It upends the powerful and the privileged and ultimately leads to Jesus' death. And Jesus would call others to follow him in this way of life. He would invite others into their own paschal mystery. What does this mean for us? I think the question is if we are willing to just be content in reading about Jesus' ministry or are we willing to enter into the life of discipleship and be doers of the word and not just hearers of the word.

Next Sunday at the 9:15AM Mass, we will celebrate the Rite of Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens (for the unbaptized) and the Rite of Welcoming the Candidates (those already baptized in another Christian faith). This ritual will officially recognize those who have completed part of the inquiry process of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) and now seek to take the next step in their journey to be one with us in the Catholic faith.

The 11:15AM Mass next week will be a school-led Mass with students from our Catholic school serving in roles such as readers, altar servers, gift bearers and choir members. This will take place as we begin Catholic Schools Week. There will also be speakers at Mass to share the good news of all that is happening with Catholic education in our parish community.

We will kick off the 2022 Bishop's Annual Appeal (BAA) the weekend of February 5-6. The Bishop's Annual Appeal supports many ministries in our diocese in the areas of Charity, Evangelization and Education. Thank you in advance for your support of this important effort in the life of our diocese.

Hoy en el Evangelio, escuchamos el pasaje de Jesús regresando a su ciudad natal y yendo a la sinagoga. Da el rollo del profeta Isaías y lee el pasaje donde Isaías dice: "El Espíritu del Señor está sobre mí, porque me ha ungido para llevar buenas nuevas a los pobres. Él me ha enviado a proclamar la libertad a los cautivos y la recuperación de la vista a los ciegos, a dejar que los oprimidos salgan libres y a proclamar un año aceptable para el Señor". Jesús leyó este pasaje con autoridad y de tal manera que todos lo miraban mientras se sentaba. Como lo hizo, dijo: "Hoy este pasaje de las Escrituras se cumple en al ser escuchado". Jesús sería el que haría todas esas cosas que Isaías profetizó. Noten, también, que todo lo que Jesús habla tiene que ver con la acción en el mundo. Pone un vuelco a los poderosos y privilegiados y, en última instancia, esto conduce a la muerte de Jesús. Y Jesús llamaría a otros a seguirlo en esta forma de vida. Invitaba a otros a su propio misterio pascual. ¿Qué significa esto para nosotros? Creo que la pregunta es si estamos dispuestos a contentarnos con leer sobre el ministerio de Jesús o si estamos dispuestos a entrar en la vida de discipulado y ser hacedores de la palabra y no solo oyentes de la palabra.





Fr. James L. Heft is a priest of the Marianist Order with a doctorate in historical theology from the University of Toronto. After faculty and administrative posts at the University of Dayton, in 2006 he founded the Institute for Advanced Catholic Studies at the University of Southern California in Los Angeles, where he is the Alton Brooks Professor of Religion and President Emeritus of the Institute.

His areas of research include the Catholic intellectual life; interreligious dialogue; Catholic secondary and higher education; and the crisis of contemporary religious disaffiliation. He has published over 170 articles and book chapters and is the author or editor of thirteen books, most recently the title of this lecture, published last year by Oxford University Press.

His service includes on the national boards of the Conference of Christians and Jews and the Association of Catholic Colleges and Universities, and the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' Education Committee. The recipient of five honorary doctorates, in 2011 he received the Theodore F. Hesburgh Award from the University of Notre Dame for distinguished and long leadership and service in Catholic higher education in the United States.

This year in STEM/PLTW, the 7th and 8th graders are taking a course called Medical Detectives that introduces them to problem solving in medical fields. They have recently completed a large unit on disease agents (viruses, bacteria, and fungi) and have learned to diagnose and treat diseases based upon symptoms and care histories. They dressed in lab coats and completed diagnostic interviews with school staff who played the roles of the patient. They have recently begun a new unit on the nervous system in which they will dissect sheep brains (which they are very excited about!).



SÍNODO 2021-2023 EN LA DIÓCESIS DE RALEIGH

¿Qué está pasando en la diócesis?

En respuesta al llamado del Santo Padre Papa Francisco, el obispo Luis Rafael Zarama ha abierto un proceso de escucha diocesana. Todos en la diócesis, incluidos aquellos que ya no están afiliados a la Iglesia, aquellos de otras religiones, o ninguna fe en particular, están invitados a proporcionar sus pensamientos con respecto a la Comunión, la Participación y la Misión en la Iglesia. Se utilizará un cuestionario electrónico en internet para recopilar información y emitir invitaciones seleccionadas al azar a aquellos que también están abiertos a asistir a sesiones de escucha y diálogo en persona a principios de 2022.
