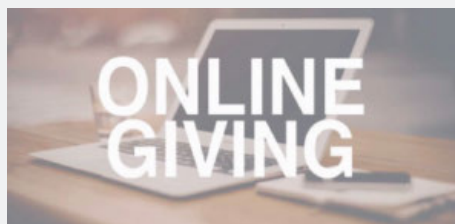

- ◇ **FORMED:** FORMED is an available online service for accessing thousands of Catholic videos, audios, and e-books on demand anytime, anywhere! Search “formed” on the parish website for more details.
- ◇ **Adult Faith Formation:** Multiple opportunities for Bible study virtually and in person will be offered at the parish. Search “adult faith” to learn more.
- ◇ **Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW) Update:** Due to the recent surge of COVID cases, there will be no CLOW in January. Details about its return will be shared when available. Search “children’s liturgy” for additional information.
