## Gospel Meditation The Baptism of the Lord

"After all the people had been baptized and Jesus also had been baptized and was praying, heaven was opened up and the Holy Spirit descended upon him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from heaven, 'You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased,'"

We don't know the exact details of how Jesus came to understand his identity and calling, but many theologians and spiritual writers have suggested that Jesus came to understand who he was and what he was called to do in a gradual way.

His process of self-understanding certainly must have been influenced by his study of the Hebrew Scriptures, by his practice of his Jewish religion, by the preaching of John the Baptist, and by his own experience of baptism.

All four Gospels describe his baptism by John as a powerful experience of God's love and acceptance and am outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon him. His life was never the same after that.

We too are called to be children of God. The Spirit is within us, God's hand and the love are there. In our baptism, God has lovingly embraced us and given us a mission.

The feast of the Baptism of Jesus celebrates the turning point in his life. When Jesus received the Spirit and went to his home territory, he was different.

The same vivid experience has to burn in our hearts too. Like Jesus, we have been specially chosen, carefully formed, and clearly sent to serve others around us.

We need to think more deeply about the effect of our own baptism on our life.


