### **DEAR PARISHIONERS,**

#### **CHRIST IS BORN! GLORIFY HIM!**



The feast of the **Baptism of the Lord** is the last day of the Christmas season, the last day of the Epiphany, the manifestation of Christ's presence begun at the Nativity. Of course, we are invited to think about our own baptism as well. Through Christ, we are all adopted sons and daughters of God the Father. And, as a child of God, we have a special mission in the world, a special mission to reveal God to the world. Now, there is another moment of Christ's life that is associated with these days of Epiphany: the Wedding Feast of Cana. We recognize Cana as the place where Jesus turned water into wine, a manifestation of his divine nature. St. John wrote this passage, linking it

closely to the Creation in Genesis and the Crucifixion (our redemption). And, at the center of all of this is a wedding. As the fundamental experience of human love--of its joys, its sacrifice-marriage is how God, who is Love, becomes present to the world. That is to say, the Sacrament of Marriage, along with the Sacrament of Baptism, are two privileged ways that Christ is manifested to the world, today.

There is so much packed into the Christmas season. There is much to unwrap.

Our **Faith Formation Program** weekly sessions begin today. We pray for our youth, their catechists, and their parents and families. May the Holy Spirit guide you all.





The Third Sunday in Ordinary Time is dedicated as The Word of God Sunday, marked by an invitation to come to a deeper appreciation of the Scriptures. QUESTIONS & ANSWERS: BADTISMAL BID

#### Question

At my grandson's Baptism, the priest put a bib on the baby. I do not remember seeing this before. Why is this done? Is it something new?

#### Answer:

When an adult is baptized, there is a part in the ceremony when the newly baptized is vested in a white garment. It is symbolic of the changes that baptism brings in the life of the baptized as they are freed from the bonds of sin and brought into the saving grace of Christ. Realities that are so profound are symbolically presented so that we might better grasp and understand them.

Infants are often dressed in a baptismal dress, which is the baptismal garment. In some places, the bib is used as a kind of baptismal garment. At the place in the ceremony where the investiture takes place, the bib is used. Some are poncho-like and fit over the baby's head. Others are simply placed on the baby's chest. If the baby is dressed in a white garment, nothing else is needed. The prayer says it all: "See in your white garment the outward sign of your Christian dignity ... bring that dignity unstained into the everlasting life of heaven." In baptism, we are given our purpose and goal in life as believers and this is symbolized by the white garment. ©LPi
