I am impressed with the two priest who have been assigned to these parishes.

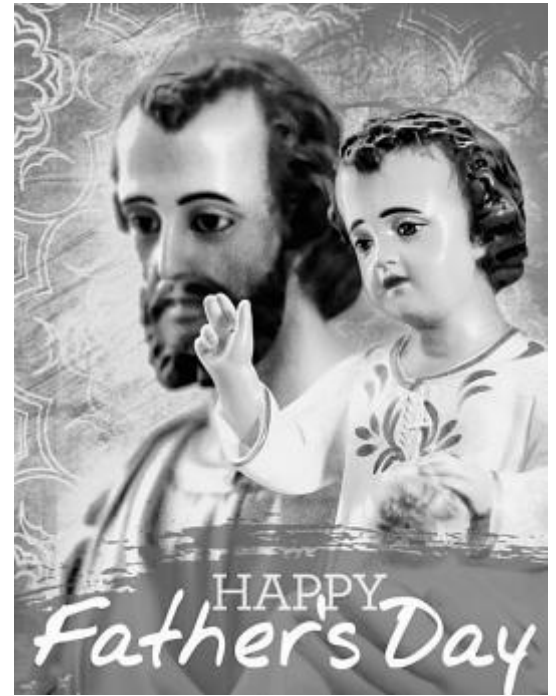
Fr Maxwell is assigned as the administrator. That is sort of a temporary title, that is usually changed to pastor after approximately one year. He has an impressive background. He has an advanced degree in moral theology. All priests get an advanced degree, but his degree is actually an advanced advanced degree, so that is extra special. As a priest, he informed us that at one time he was pastor of a cluster of 20 parishes. I guess there is no room for me to ever complain about having three parishes, when there are people out there like Fr Maxwell who at one time had 20 parishes! He was also the Vicar General of his native diocese. The Vicar General is the second person 'in charge' in the diocese, right after the Bishop. So he has extensive experience and is very accomplished.

Fr Nick is assigned the parochial vicar. I was in seminary with Fr. Nick for a year. He is very intelligent, graduating from the University of Virginia and worked as a teacher after graduation. Specifically, he was a Spanish teacher, so his fluency in Spanish will be a great benefit, especially to working with the Hispanic community. Fr. Nick is a zealous priest who loves the Catholic faith. He also serves as the assistant vocations director for our diocese.

I am grateful to the Bishop for providing these two priests to St. Peter, St. John and St. Patrick. There is so much good that is done in our parishes and it is a great comfort, having served here for 6 years, to know the parishes will be handed over to good leaders.

And ultimately we know who is the chief Shepherd. He will tirelessly care for those in need who walk through the doors of our parishes, providing grace and nourishment for their spirits. We have never anything to fear since He is charge.
