





A brief explanation of the Divine Mercy Image

The image of the Divine Mercy is a depiction of Jesus Christ that is based on the visions St. Maria Faustina Kowalska had of our Lord. St. Maria was a nun who lived in Poland and on February 22 1931, Jesus appeared to her as the "King of Divine Mercy" and was robed in a white garment. She wrote that Jesus' right hand was raised in blessing, the other was touching the garment near his Sacred Heart, and that from his heart, streamed two large rays, one red, the other white. The red rays stand for the blood of Jesus, or the Eucharist, and the white rays stand for water, or Baptism. St. Maria directed the painting of the first image. The whole image is a symbol of charity, forgiveness and love of God, who is the "Fountain of Divine Mercy." St. John Paul II canonized St. Maria on April 30, 2000, the first saint of the new millennium. The Chaplet of Divine Mercy has its source from the visions of St. Maria and is a very popular devotion. Many pray the chaplet at 3pm, the hour of mercy, and in the presence of the dying. St. Maria wrote in her diary that Jesus told her, "I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish. I also promise victory over enemies already here on earth, especially at the hour of death. I myself will defend it as My own glory."

It is very appropriate that this image of the Divine Mercy is hung outside the confessional.
