From the Pastor's desk,

Today, in the middle of the Christmas season, we celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord. The collect (opening prayer) of Mass reads:

***O God, who on this day
revealed your Only Begotten Son to the nations
by the guidance of a star,
grant in your mercy
that we, who know you already by faith,
may be brought to behold the beauty of your sublime glory.***

We are modern-day magi, following the light, seeking the newborn King. While the rest of the world has already set Christmas aside and moved on to the next thing, we are here today, pondering this great mystery and great good news. Let us come and adore alongside the original magi.

Today presents an opportunity to bless your home, which is a wonderful Catholic tradition. Above the doorways of your home, write with chalk:

20 + C + M + B + 22

The numerals consecrate the new year and the letters are the initials of the names of the magi, Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar. The letters also stand for the Latin motto *Christus mansionem benedicat* (May Christ bless this house). You can also sprinkle your house or living area with holy water at the same time.

It is hard to believe that it is already 2022. It was good to begin the New Year with prayer, celebrating Mass, worshipping God and honoring Mary, the Mother of God (and our mother). While the New Year is still young, consider making a resolution that will help you continue to grow in your faith, hope and love. By putting Christ at the center of our lives this year, we will be more open to receive His many graces and blessings, and even crosses, that will help us on our journey to holiness – the goal of human life.

Thanks to all who contributed so generously to our parish and to our charitable ministries in December. This includes time, talent and treasure! So many give so much. We could not do what we do without your generous help.

Please remember that this Thursday January 6th, I will hear confessions from 6:30-7:30pm at St. Saviour, and then on Friday, January 7th, we will have Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 3-6pm at St. John.

Pray for our new Beacons of Light Family of Parishes, and pray for the pastor of this family, beginning July 1.

Many will be returning to school and work this week. May God bless our work this year and make it fruitful for eternal life.

Next Sunday is the Baptism of the Lord. The Christmas season officially ends with this celebration.
