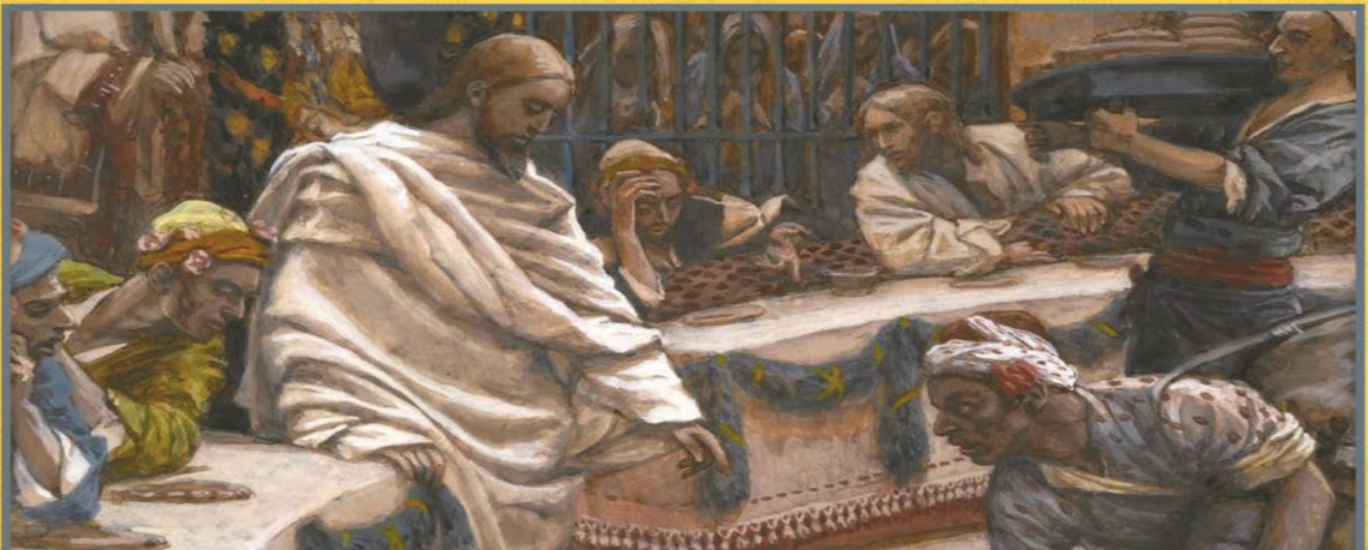

At a wedding feast at Cana, Christ performed the first of the seven signs (miracles) recounted in the Gospel of John. The lack of wine threatens to spoil the celebration of new love. But the Mother of God notices the need and speaks to her Son. With one word from his Mother, Jesus reveals his divinity so that all people can realize just how much God rejoices in us – just as a bridegroom rejoices in his bride. Just as it did for his first disciples, this revelation of glory leads us to deeper belief in Christ. The miracle of “good wine” continues through the outpouring of the spiritual gifts of the Holy Spirit, and the chalice of salvation on the altar at every Mass. (Magnificat)

Monday is the national holiday honoring the birth of Martin Luther King Jr. We remember the good that this man and the civil rights movement accomplished. It is good to pray and work for an end to racial discrimination. Enjoy the long holiday weekend.

This Saturday, January 22<sup>nd</sup>, we remember the terrible and tragic decision in 1973 by the Supreme Court legalizing abortion. It is a decision that has terribly divided this country. So many millions of innocent lives have been lost. Every one of them had a right to life. Along with each abortion, mothers and fathers also are wounded and suffer.

Please keep in your prayers an intention that God may one day soon remove this scourge of legalized abortion from our country. And pray for healing for all who have suffered an abortion, and conversion for those thinking of an abortion. We are very grateful that now there are so many prolife groups and organizations who help women in need. We hope that the culture of life will one day soon replace the culture of death we live in.

Pray for the safety of all who will be traveling to and from Washington DC to March for Life on Friday, January 21.

There will be a **Vocation Night** on Wednesday, January 26, at Mt. St. Mary's Seminary in Mt. Washington on Beechmont Ave. This is a chance for college age men and older to visit the seminary, attend Mass, enjoy dinner, take a tour, and spend some time with our current seminarians. 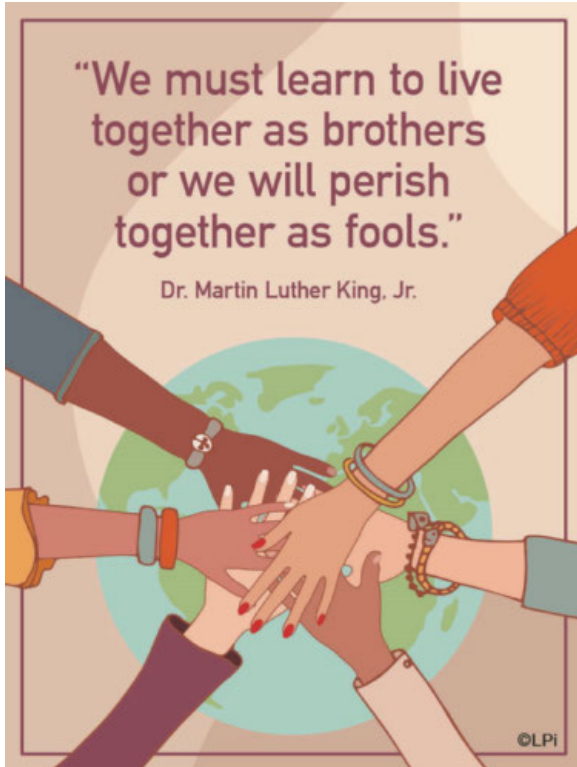

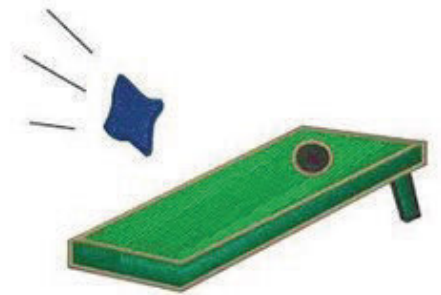
