From the Pastor's desk

Saint Luke writes his Gospel so that the reader will “realize the certainty of the teachings” received. That certainty flows from the man in the synagogue who reads the scroll of Isaiah and promises that he will bring glad tidings to the poor, proclaim liberty to captives, give sight to the blind, and let the oppressed go free. Only God can work such wonders; that is why rejoicing in the Lord in our midst must be our strength. As the eyes of all those assembled in the synagogue looked intently at Jesus, they became an image of what we must do as members of the body of Christ – unite ourselves to him in faith and love. (Magnificat)

Congratulations to all the boys and girls who made their First Reconciliation this past Wednesday. It is a great day in their lives and their families' lives. May they all grow in their love for this Sacrament.

This Sunday, January 23, we remember the sad and tragic decisions in 1973 by the Supreme Court legalizing abortion. It is a decision that has terribly divided this country. So many millions of innocent lives have been lost. Every one of them had a right to life. Along with each abortion, mothers and fathers also are wounded and suffer. Please keep in your prayers an intention that God may one day soon remove this scourge of legalized abortion from our country. And pray for healing for all who have suffered an abortion, and conversion for those thinking of an abortion. We are very grateful that now there are so many prolife groups and organizations who help women in need. We hope that the culture of life will one day soon replace the culture of death we live in.

Washington on Beechmont Ave. This is a chance for college aged men and older to visit the seminary, attend Mass, enjoy dinner, take a tour, and spend some time with our current seminarians. 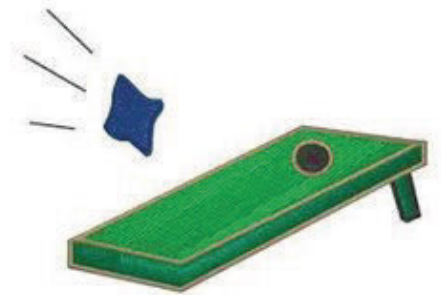

Join the synod on synodality

Pope Francis has called a synod in Rome in October 2023.

He wants the church to be more synodal, meaning it prays and listens to all members of the church, not bishops alone. He wants this effort to flow from all of the people of God, all over the world.

In Cincinnati, the process has begun with meetings around the archdiocese. More than 150 people met at Good Shepherd on Jan. 13, for instance. Two key questions are:

- How is the Church journeying together to advance its mission?
- What steps is the Holy Spirit inviting us to take to go forward together?

The four topics discussed at the Thursday night meeting were:

- 1) Describe an experience you had of a group working together, so that the Holy Spirit worked among you.
- 2) What is the mission of the church, and what parts of that are we neglecting? How can we be more effective?
- 3) What voices are not heard? What prevents people from listening and speaking up?
- 4) How can we improve participation and transparency?

More meetings are scheduled through February. Locations in Hamilton County include:

- Saturday, Jan. 29, 9-11 am St. Francis Xavier downtown
- Thursday, Feb. 10, 7-9 pm Mount St. Mary's Seminary

A Zoom meeting also may be scheduled at the end of February.

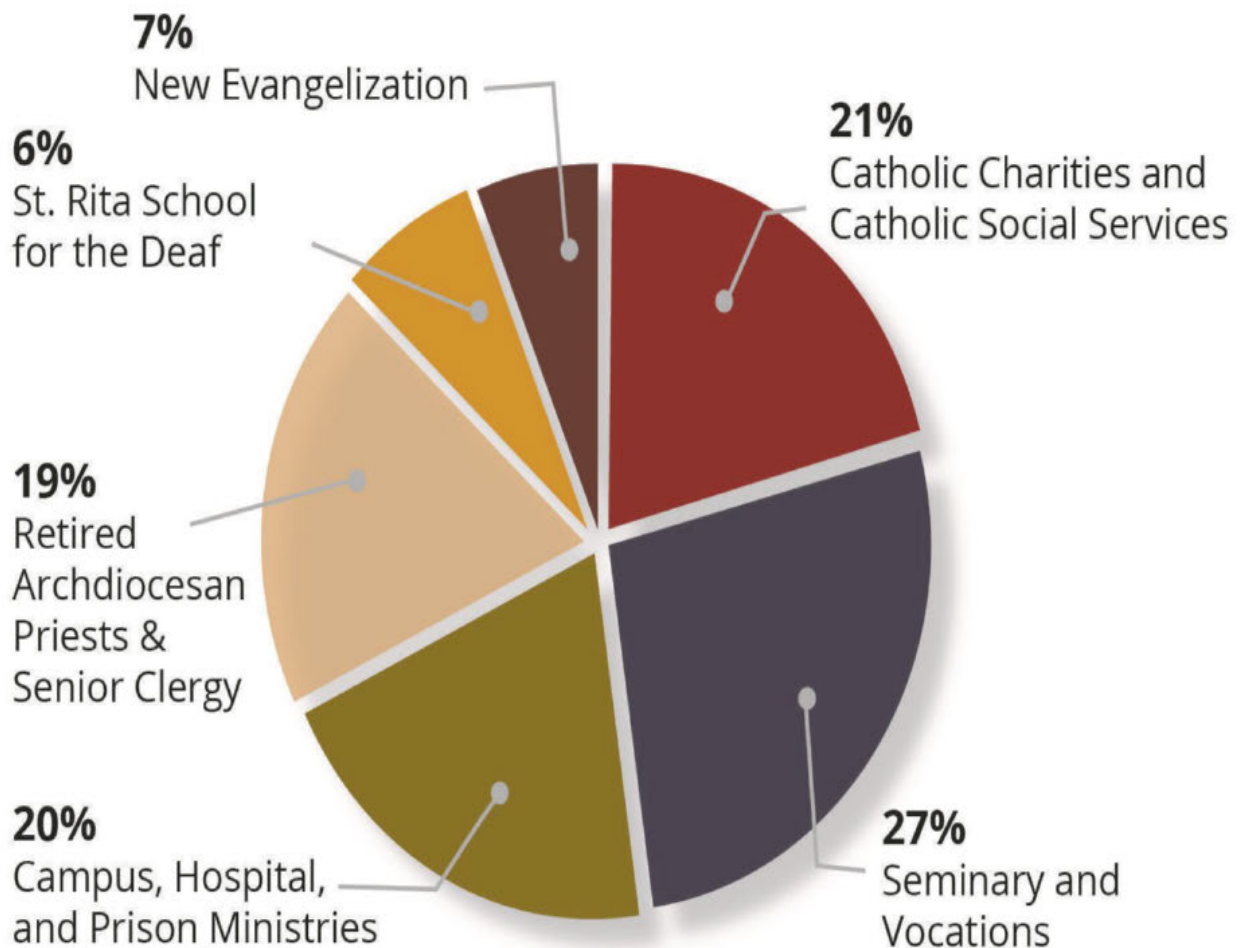
