From the Pastor's desk

The people who hear Jesus preach in the synagogue are amazed at his gracious words. Yet they insist on measuring him according to their own flawed standards and expectations. But “when the perfect comes, the partial will pass away,” and the perfect has come in Jesus Christ. The prophetic words of Christ enable us to know fully, even as we are fully known by God from the first moment he formed us in the womb. This mutual knowing leads us to love him and take refuge in him. The furious people of Nazareth try to kill Jesus, yet he safely passes through the midst of them, leaving his believers with this assurance: They will fight against you but will not prevail, for I am with you to deliver you. “Love never fails.” (Magnificat)

It seems that this January has had an unusually long stretch of cold weather, and yet, maybe this is really what it normally should be, and we just have not had this long stretch in recent years. Either way, it is always good to say good-bye to January and its cold weather and long nights. As we begin February, there are some important liturgical events coming up which bring us warmth and light. Please join us for one or more of the following:



Join the synod on synodality

Pope Francis has called a synod in Rome in October 2023.

He wants the church to be more synodal, meaning it prays and listens to all members of the church, not bishops alone. He wants this effort to flow from all of the people of God, all over the world.

In Cincinnati, the process has begun with meetings around the archdiocese. More than 150 people met at Good Shepherd on Jan. 13, for instance. Two key questions are:

- How is the Church journeying together to advance its mission?
- What steps is the Holy Spirit inviting us to take to go forward together?

The four topics discussed at the Thursday night meeting were:

- 1) Describe an experience you had of a group working together, so that the Holy Spirit worked among you.
- 2) What is the mission of the church, and what parts of that are we neglecting? How can we be more effective?
- 3) What voices are not heard? What prevents people from listening and speaking up?
- 4) How can we improve participation and transparency?

More meetings are scheduled through February. Locations in Hamilton County include:

Thursday, Feb. 10, 7-9 pm Mount St. Mary's Seminary

A Zoom meeting also may be scheduled at the end of February.


