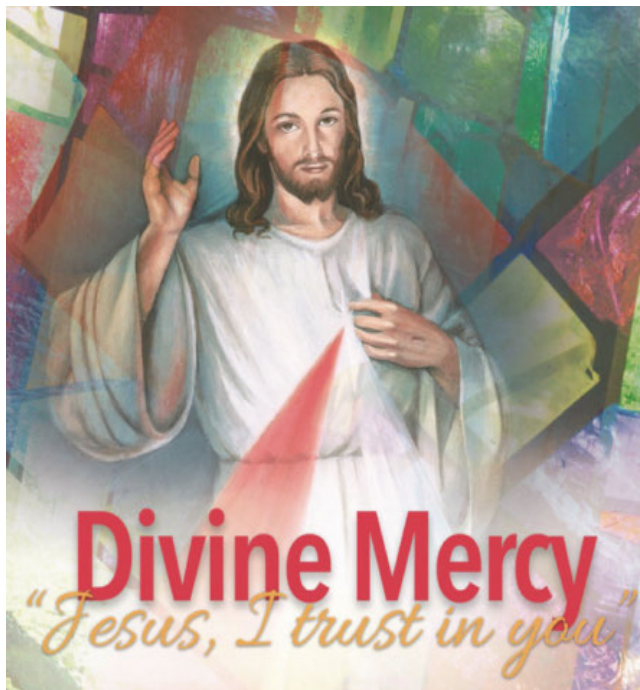

From the Pastor's Desk

The week after Easter and the following Sunday in the past were sometimes called the time of Divine Mercy. Our Lord had risen from the dead, and He met many people who had failed Him badly. The apostles and the disciples had run away and left Him. Except for His Mother, the holy women and John, He had gone to the Cross alone. He came back from the dead and He was merciful and kind to those who had failed Him.

Today we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday, instituted by St. John Paul II in the year 2000. We reflect on how at times we have failed to love God and our neighbor, and also on God's infinite mercy for us and our world. Take some time and ask for God's mercy and think of those wonderful words "Jesus, I trust in You."

Please join us this Sunday afternoon at St. Saviour as we celebrate this devotion. Beginning at 3pm, we will have a holy hour, with exposition and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, the rosary and concluding with Benediction. I will hear confessions beginning at 4pm.

Thanks to all who have contributed generously to our parishes, whatever amount you have given. As disciples of Jesus Christ, it is good to support our parish, so that we can continue to spread the Gospel in our community. Without your support and stewardship, we could not. Thanks to all for a generous Easter collection!

Today, we have a young boy making his First Communion, and next Sunday, our second grade boys and girls will make their First Holy Communion. Some at St. Saviour and some at St. Johns. Please keep them in your prayers as they prepare to receive our Lord in the Eucharist for the first time. We congratulate them and their families on this very important day. May they always come and feast on the Bread from heaven.

Today is the last day of PSR, our Parish School of Religion. We hope and pray that it was a good year for all our young boys and girls, that they learned more about our God, our Church, the Sacraments and prayer. We thank our parents who bring their children to the classes and hope they continue to teach their children the faith during the summer. We thank our CRE Halie Cloar for helping with this program, and all the volunteer teachers, aides and staff who made this possible. We hope to see everyone at Mass over the summer, and back again in the fall.

Next Sunday also begins the month of May, and we all know that it is dedicated to Mary. We honor Mary for many reasons, most especially because she is the Mother of God, Jesus Christ. A beautiful way to honor Mary is to pray the rosary. Consider doing this once a week with your family. It will bring your family great blessings and graces.
