From the Pastor's Desk

In the face of Peter's triple denial of him on the eve of his Passion, the risen Jesus asks Peter three times, "Do you love me?" Jesus draws out from Peter a love that makes reparation. Jesus uses Peter's own humiliation and contrition to give him deeper love. The "honor and glory and blessing" that the slain Lamb is worthy to receive is this confidence in his love even when we know we have sinned and betrayed him. Like Peter, "We must obey God rather than men" – which means that we remain confident in Christ's love even when our own weak humanity tempts us to give up. (Magnificat)

This weekend, we are very happy for our children who received their First Holy Communion. What a great day in their lives, and in the lives of their families. If you love someone, you want to be close to them. We see this in husbands and wives, parents and their children, and mutual friends, etc. Is it any different between God and us, and us and God? God loves us so much that he comes to us in this special sacrament to be close to us and we to him. As Catholics, we are so blessed. Thanks to all who have worked so hard to prepare our children, especially Marlene O'Brien.

As Pope John Paul II wrote in his encyclical on the Eucharist, "The Church draws her life from the Eucharist." Just as our physical bodies need food, so do our spiritual souls. The Eucharist is the greatest of all spiritual food, because Jesus himself is present under the appearance of bread and wine. That is why it is important that we all receive the Eucharist every Sunday at Mass.

May is the Month of Mary and the Rosary. During this month of May, please consider praying the rosary, especially as a family. It is a beautiful and powerful prayer to our Blessed Mother. Remember Our Lady of Fatima gave the children several messages, (1) to have a devotion to her Immaculate Heart and (2) pray the rosary and do penance for the conversion of sinners.

Next Sunday is World Day of Prayer for Vocations. This is not a one-day celebration, but an opportunity to re-energize our parish to promote vocations, to the priesthood, deaconate, and religious life. St John's Parish is very blessed to have a young woman, Sr. Zelie Marie Bosse, Novice, with the Dominican Sisters of Mary, Mother of the Eucharist.

Please pray that more young men and women answer the call to follow our Lord in the priesthood or religious life.


