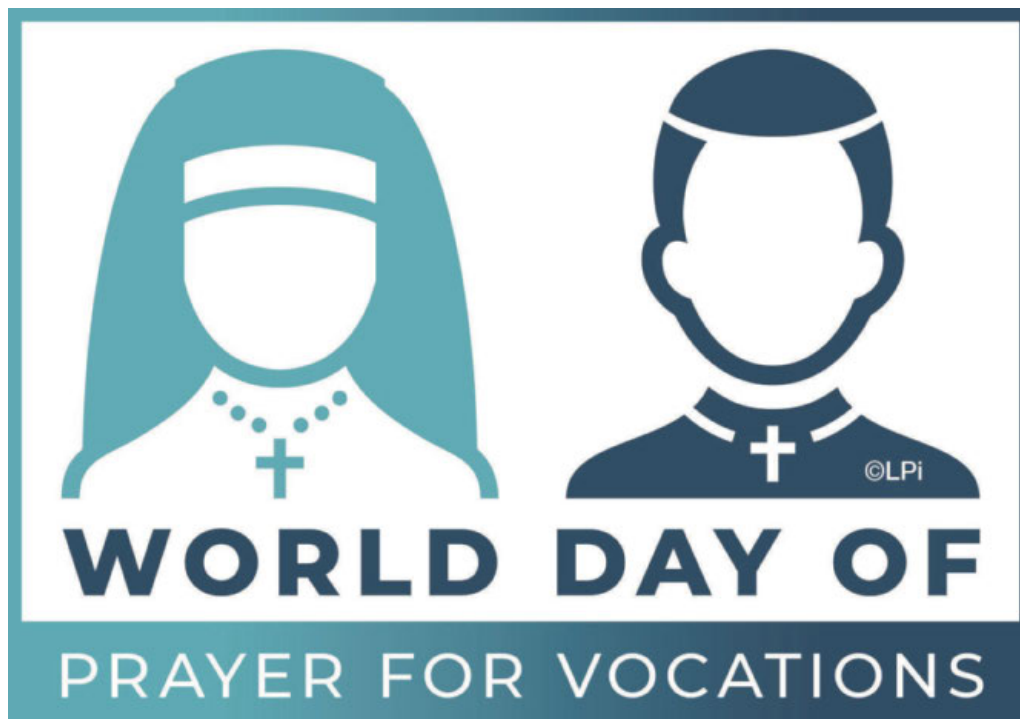

From the Pastor's Desk

**On this day, O Beautiful Mother
On this day we give thee our love;
Near thee Madonna fondly we hover
Trusting thy gentle care to prove.**

This is the refrain from a beautiful Marian hymn that many of us learned in grade school. As we celebrate Mother's day, we know that we have an earthly mother and a heavenly mother. We honor and thank them both. Without them we would not be here, and we would not be the man or woman that we are today. There are some in our parish who will miss mom today, and we keep them both in our prayers.

On this Good Shepherd Sunday, the risen Christ consoles us: "My sheep hear my voice; they follow me." What fills Christ's disciples with joy and the Holy Spirit is this voice, which is identical with life. Like the converts whom Paul and Barnabas urged to "to remain faithful to the grace of God," our happiness lies in our faithfulness to the tender voice of the Shepherd. For this Shepherd is also the Lamb who lives to wipe every tear from our eyes. With Saint Gregory of Nyssa we say: "How could I not love you, who have loved me so much as to lay down your life for the sheep whose shepherd you are? There can be no greater love than this, to lay down your life for my salvation." (Magnificat)

Please keep in your prayers that young men and women listen to the voice of the Good Shepherd, guiding them to their vocation in life. May more young men and women be open our Lord inviting them to be priests or consecrated women. Also, we need men to discern their call to the diaconate. Please pray for them.

May is the Month of Mary and the Rosary. During this month of May, please consider praying the rosary, especially as a family. It is a beautiful and powerful prayer to our Blessed Mother. Remember Our Lady of Fatima gave the children several messages, (1) to have a devotion to her Immaculate Heart and (2) pray the rosary and do penance for the conversion of sinners.

Please pray for our country, as it is divided on so many issues, but especially the issue of unborn human life. Life begins at conception, and no one has the right to take the life of an innocent person, especially the unborn. We pray that all people, especially women who are with child, would choose life. And may all grow in their knowledge and understanding of the nature and purpose of human sexuality, created by God, that it is to unite a man and woman in marriage and be open to life.

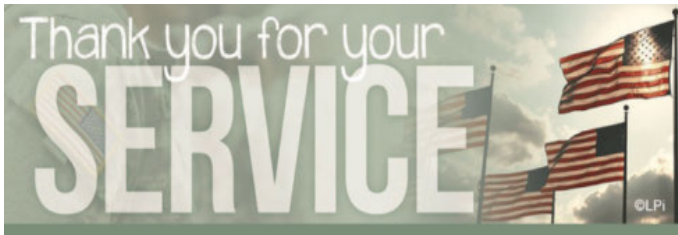


Brag on Your Grad

It's Mothers Day

It's the second Sunday in May, time to recognize mothers.

Has anybody ever told you that your mother had to have been a saint to put up with you? They were joking, right?

It's not a joking matter that Mothers Day has been celebrated for a bit more than a century in the United States, with good reason .

Across the centuries, the church has celebrated many women as saints who were mothers. Some of them are:

Mary, the Mother of God

Feast Days of Mary include: Jan. 1 Solemnity of Mary; Feb. 11 Our Lady of Lourdes; March 25 Annunciation; May 13 Our Lady of Fatima; May 31 Visitation; Aug. 15 Assumption; Dec. 8 Immaculate Conception; Dec. 12 Our Lady of Guadalupe

St. Anne (the grandma of Jesus)

Feast Day Aug. 15

St. Elizabeth, the mother of John the Baptist

Feast Day Nov. 5

St. Martha (you know, the one who did all the work in the Bible)

Feast Day July 29

Sts. Felicity and Perpetua, 3rd Century martyrs. Listen for their names during Mass.

Feast Day March 7

St. Monica, the mother of St. Augustine of Hippo in the Fourth Century. She "wrestled with God" for 17 years before her son converted to Christianity. His writings have come down through the ages to us.

Feast Day Aug. 27

St. Waltrude, who lived in the Seventh Century, was married to St. Vincent Madelgarius. They raised four children, who also became saints.

Feast Day April 9

St. Zita, a 13th Century Italian woman, is the patron saint of domestic workers.

Feast Day April 27

St. Elizabeth of Hungary, who also lived in the 13th century, is the patron saint of widows.

Feast Day Nov. 17

St. Elizabeth of Portugal, the great-niece of St. Elizabeth of Hungary, was a peacemaker within her family.

Feast Day July 4

St. Frances of Rome lived in the 1300s and 1400s, but still is the patron saint of automobile drivers. According to legend, an angel lit the road in front of her with a lantern when she traveled.

Feast Day March 9

St. Zelie and St. Louis Martin, who lived in the 1800s, were the parents of St. Therese of Lisieux. Their daughter is a doctor of the church.

Feast Day of Sts. Zelie and Louis July 12

St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, a mother and pioneering educator, was the first person born in the United States to be canonized.

Feast Day Jan. 4

St. Gianna Molla, a pediatrician who faced dire consequences when she was pregnant. She refused a hysterectomy, so that her child could live. St. Gianna died, but her daughter grew up to become a doctor herself.

Feast Day April 28

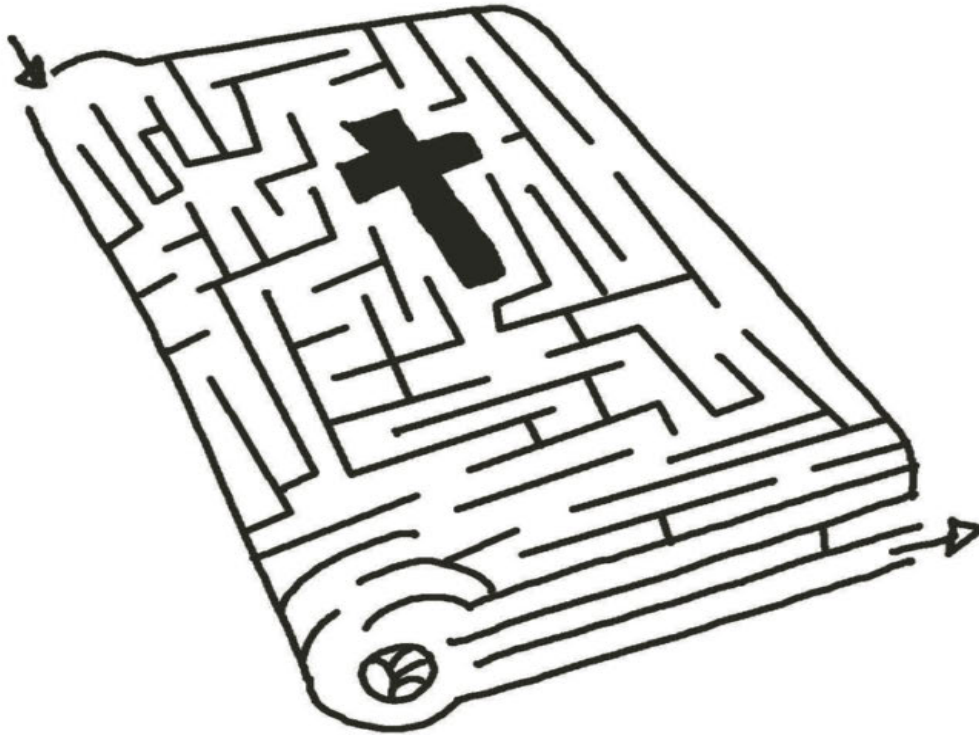

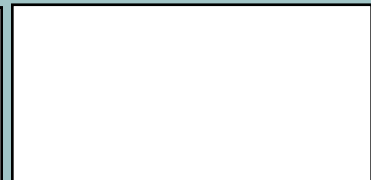
