From the Pastor's desk

Christ's promise at the Last Supper "Whoever loves me will keep my word, and my Father and I will make our dwelling with him" is all that we need to be happy. Barnabas and Paul "dedicate their lives to the name of our Lord Jesus Christ" that they might gleam with the splendor of God and draw others into the apostolic faith. God acknowledges such dedication by ordaining that the names of the twelve apostles be inscribed on the wall of the heavenly Jerusalem. The same is offered to us who refuse to let our hearts be troubled, but who cling to the name of Christ instead. (Magnificat)

Today we welcome Fr. Blane Grein at the 9am Mass. He is uncle to parishioner Kathy Wietmarschen. Fr. Blane is celebrating his 60th anniversary of ordination as a Franciscan priest. He lives in New Mexico. Congratulations Fr. Blane.

May is the Month of Mary and the Rosary. During this month of May, please consider praying the rosary, especially as a family. It is a beautiful and powerful prayer to our Blessed Mother. Remember Our Lady of Fatima gave the children several messages, (1) to have a devotion to her Immaculate Heart and (2) pray the rosary and do penance for the conversion of sinners.

Please pray for our country, as it is divided on so many issues, but especially the issue of unborn human life. Life begins at conception, and no one has the right to take the life of an innocent person, especially the unborn. We pray that all people, especially women who are with child, would choose life. And may all grow in their knowledge and understanding of the nature and purpose of human sexuality, created by God, that it is to unite a man and woman in marriage and be open to life.

Please keep in your prayers the seven men who will be ordained to priesthood on Saturday, May 21 for our Archdiocese. We are thankful that they have chosen to accept the call to the priesthood and give their lives to the Church. May God bless them and make their priesthood fruitful.

I will be away on retreat the week of May 22, leaving Sunday afternoon and returning Friday evening May 27th. Please keep me in your prayers and I will pray for you.

On Sunday May 29th at 12:30pm we will have a parish luncheon at St. Saviour cafeteria to help celebrate my 20th ordination anniversary. God has been very good to me in these twenty years, and I have been blessed in serving and working with so many good people. It has been a while since I have given an update on our activities. Rather than review numbers such as people helped, visits made, dollar amounts of assistance, etc., I would like to touch on something even more important. One of the tenets of our mission is to meet neighbors in their homes. This is a more personal way to learn about their needs and situation vs. them waiting in line at some government agency to seek help. We can discern if there are other needs we may be able to help with beyond what they have originally requested. Prayer is a part of these visits, and we ask if they are OK if we pray together. It is very moving to see a grown man or woman with tears streaming down their face at the conclusion of a prayer. It is not due to the monetary assistance; rather, I believe, it may be the first time they have ever heard someone praying for them. This often means more to them than any financial help we can provide. Know that we also pray for you, our benefactors, that make our work possible.

We have a fifth Sunday collection coming up on Sunday May 29th. Please be as generous as you are able. Rising rents, utilities and general inflation are impacting those in our neighborhood that can least afford it. If you do write a check, please make it out to St. Vincent DePaul rather than to St. John Parish. This will expedite our ability to get the funds deposited in our account and put them to work for our neighbors in need.

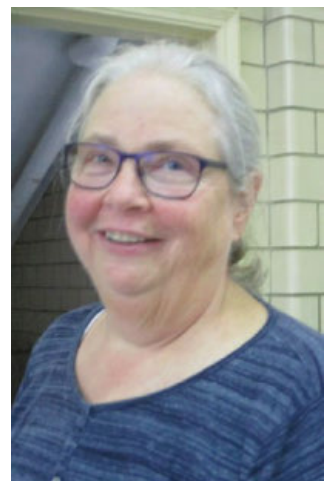
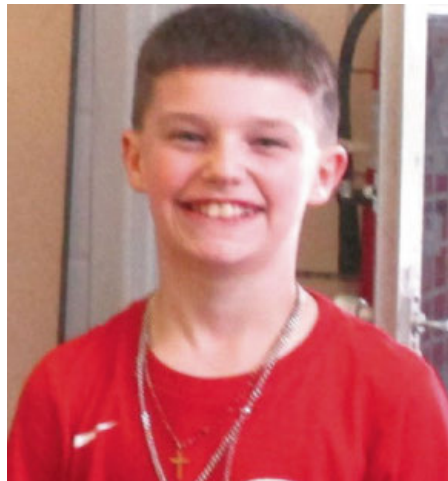
WE LOVE A PARADE

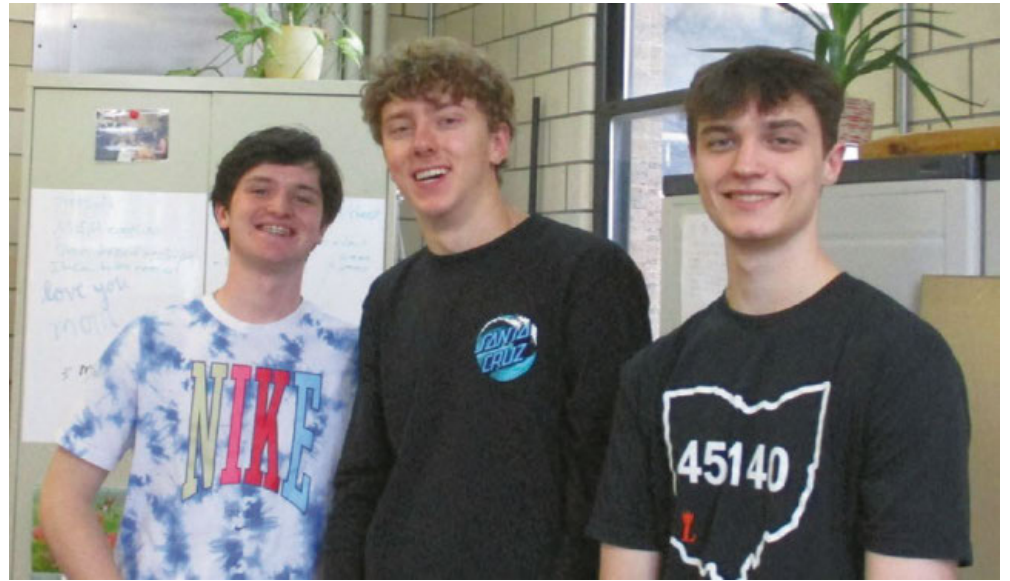

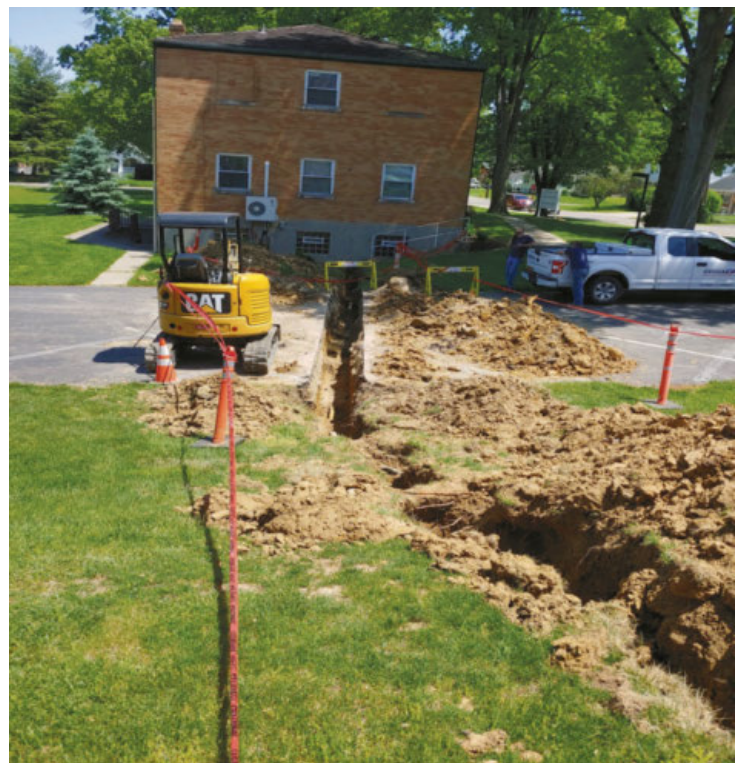

Dear St. Saviour parishioners,
You may have noticed the long trench that has been dug in the past week or so between the school and the parish office. About two weeks ago the school maintenance man noticed the smell of gas in the school. The school was canceled for the day and the gas valve to the school was closed. A leak was detected outside school, and after digging, our HVAC people found a problem with the gas pipe right under the school cornerstone. (see picture) After replacing the pipe, the HVAC workers tested the pipe to make sure it was holding pressure, and found that it was NOT! So, they dug next to the parish office building thinking there might be the same type of problem there, but no problem was found. All they could do was keep digging and checking for the leak. As bad luck would have it, they found a gash in the pipe the last place they dug. It must have been nicked when it was installed years ago, and slowly rusted to the point when a hole opened up, allowing gas to escape. No one knows how long this pipe has been leaking gas. So now we are waiting for the 'right' replacement pipe to be delivered and then installed. This has turned into an expensive repair! And one more thing, while digging the trench, the workers cut the unseen underground parish telephone line. Sorry that our phone lines have been down this past week. Hopefully the phone lines are reconnected and working by the time you read this. Pray for Shannon Benvenuti, our parish business manager. It has not been a good week. The good news is that this did not happen in the middle of winter!

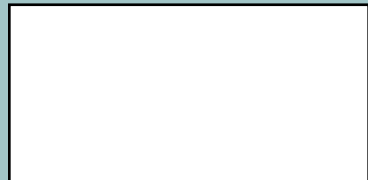
