TWO ITEMS

MY NEW ASSIGNMENTS

Last year, I was asked to serve on the Priest Retirement Board and I did so. This year, I have been asked to chair the board. Along with chairing the Board, this assignment comes with an appointment to the Presbyteral Council, a group of priests serving as advisors to the bishop. Both of these committees meet quarterly in the afternoons and, for the most part, no one will notice when I am away from our parish campus. However, one of the committees will create some conflicts with regularly scheduled events on the calendar during the coming year. Three times, there will be conflicts with nursing home Masses. As we get closer to the effected dates, I will arrange to find a substitute priest or reschedule these Masses for different days. Another conflict will be during a Day of Grace, but that will not occur until May 2025 and we will make adjustments as necessary.

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

Again, on behalf of the parish, I want to express my gratitude to all who contributed to the campaign. Many made pledges to contribute over the course of five years. Having had many of these conversations asking for the pledges, I know it was often difficult to make such a decision. Many were willing to make sacrifices to support the campaign, but were also unsure where they would be financially next year, let alone in five years. We have all been impacted by the inflationary increases in prices, and some of us have not seen such equalizing increases in our income. If you are struggling to maintain your pledge while also providing for your other needs, please contact me to discuss your situation and how we may help. Of course, if your financial situation has improved and you would like to increase your pledge, I am also willing to talk about that opportunity.

Baptisms are scheduled on the fourth Sunday of the month and during Masses as requested.


Sacrament of Marriage


Family Faith Formation & Sacrament Prep

What? Family Faith Formation (Fx3)

Why do we need ongoing formation? God's plan of loving goodness invites us to be united with Him eternally, to be set apart for holiness and become saints. The Catholic Faith is rich in beauty and truth with three main pillars or legs: Sacred Scripture, Sacred Tradition, and Magisterial Teachings (the Church). We need ongoing formation to encounter Jesus Christ through these pillars and to live virtuously. We also need formation in order to prepare to receive God's loving grace through the Sacraments.

Families with children attending public school in grades K-8 should register now!

Parents of children in Catholic school are also invited to participate.

Who should register? All parish families with children in grades K-8 who are not already enrolled in a Catholic school. Faith formation is a lifelong process and all children, especially when preparing to receive Sacraments should be enrolled. Lifelong formation is, of course, also for adults, which is a benefit of family formation. Families within Catholic schools are always welcome and encouraged to

participate in the monthly Family Faith Formation sessions.

When does Family Faith Formation meet? Sessions are held 1-2 times per month on Sunday mornings between the 8 AM and 10:15 AM Masses from 9:05-10:05 AM. Eighth grade Confirmation gatherings are on Sunday evenings from 6-7:30 PM with 24 sessions that are a hybrid of online, in-person, and independent gatherings.

How do we sign up? Use the QR code in the graphic above. The fee per family is \$65 with additional fees for sacrament retreats for 2nd and 8th grade participants, collected separately and after sessions begin.

Reflect



