### A message from the Finance Council

If you are a retiree over the age of 70 and 1/2, you may want to consider donating to St. Leo's from your IRA via a Qualified Charitable Distribution. The advantage of doing this is that these funds are NOT taxed by the federal government. However, you must follow the rules to make this work. First, contact your investment company and have them make out a check to St. Leo's in the amount you desire and send it to your home. That way, you can send it to St. Leo's with a letter so that we know that the check is coming from you. Second, when you prepare your federal tax return, make sure that you list the total amount of distributions from your retirement accounts on Line 4a but subtract your QCD from the amount you list on Line 4b. Write QCD next to it so that the IRS knows why the amount is reduced.

This may sound complicated but, once you set it up, it's fairly easy. You can give up to \$100,000 this way each year (don't we wish!).

If you are a retiree over the age of 72, and thus are required to withdraw funds from your IRA each year via Required Minimum Distributions, you can do so via a QCD as indicated above and not need to pay income tax on that distribution.
