



3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Human history reveals many periods where people lost a sense of God's transcendence. It may even be argued that human beings have been wandering and lost more than they have been at home and focused. Human nature being what it is, we struggle with who God really is — the God of our salvation history or the “gods” of human constructs. Relying on our own designs and pursuits, we forget that we really are meant to listen to One upon whom the Spirit of the Lord rests, Jesus Christ, and not to ourselves. That same history that reveals our fickleness and infidelity also reveals God's constancy and faithfulness. God always finds us.

As people wander and fumble to find their way, God is there bringing them back to holiness and giving them the assurance of His presence. We have to allow God's Word, God's life, to touch us and change us. It can make us more flexible and attentive to the sacred in all facets of life so that every day is one that is holy. Every day is a time when fulfillment is possible for one's soul. Jesus stood before those gathered in the synagogue as the fulfillment of words of promise that were echoed long ago. God doesn't forget. He always comes for us.

Now it is time to remember to go to God. Sometimes our lives are so confused and tangled that it is difficult to see the Word and hand of God. But when we realize, deep within, the depth of friendship God offers to us it really has the power to turn sadness to joy. The promise is fulfilled. Going frequently to God's Word, allowing ourselves to be enriched and rejuvenated, and pondering the certainty of God's fidelity and promise permanently transforms us. We will be more aware of the sacred and the holy and less invested in things that pull us away.




SAINT OF THE WEEK St. Thomas Aquinas January 28


One of the most famous members of the Dominican Order, St. Thomas Aquinas (1225 – 1274) is well-known by many for his theological work, “*The Summa Theologiae*.” Born in Italy, his mother wanted him to become a Benedictine and had high hopes that he would eventually become abbot of Monte Cassino, where he spent much of his youth. To change his vocation, she had him kidnapped by his brothers on his way to Paris at the age of 19. He spent two years in their captivity. Despite this, nothing could shake him from his vocation to become a Dominican priest and he was eventually released. Once free, he went to Paris and then to Cologne, where he finished his studies with Albert the Great.

His greatest contribution to the Catholic Church is his writings. The unity, harmony, and continuity of faith and reason, of revealed and natural human knowledge, encompasses his writings. The *Summa Theologiae*, his last and, unfortunately, uncompleted work, deals with the whole of Catholic theology.

The patron saint of teachers, theologians and students, St. Thomas Aquinas died in 1274. His life and the impact he had on the whole Church, however, remains alive today.

3er Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Para ser efectivos en la misión que él nos encomienda como bautizados, debemos de tener amor por los demás y saber reconciliarnos unos a otros, tomando la dirección apropiada que demuestre que somos discípulos suyos. Jesús pasó haciendo el bien, curando y haciendo milagros porque sabía que: *“El Espíritu del Señor esta sobre mí. Él me ha ungido para llevar buenas noticias a los pobres, para anunciar la libertad a los cautivos y a los ciegos que pronto van a ver, para poner en libertad a los oprimidos y proclamar el año de gracia del Señor” (Lucas 4,18-19).* ¿Qué buenas noticias llevas tú a los que te rodean?

Primera Lectura:

Esdras y Nehemías fueron los líderes religiosos y políticos de Judá a mediados del siglo quinto A.C. Ellos basaron su liderazgo en las Escrituras (“el libro de la ley”). ¿Qué papel tienen las Sagradas Escrituras en guiar tu vida?

Segunda Lectura:

Evangelio:

Lucas es el único evangelista que nos proporciona un prólogo que describe su motivación para escribir su Evangelio. ¿Qué detalles te parecen más interesantes del prólogo de Lucas?

Vivir La Liturgia

La gente puede perder fácilmente el sentido de lo sagrado y trascendente. Cuando perdemos el sentido de la presencia especial de Dios, necesitamos ser devueltos. Esdras hizo que la gente volviera a la palabra de Dios y se dieron cuenta de lo que se estaban perdiendo. Jesús proclama la palabra de Dios en la sinagoga con verdadera convicción y les dice a los reunidos que Él es el cumplimiento de todo lo que Isaías enseñó. Aunque las personas se pierden, se distraen, se desaniman y, a menudo, viajan por el camino equivocado, la ley eterna de Dios permanece. Cuando nos permitimos escuchar verdaderamente la palabra de Dios y actuar de acuerdo con ella, esa palabra viva, con el tiempo, nos cambia lentamente. Tiene el poder de ablandarnos y moldearnos, creando dentro de nosotros un espíritu alegre. Nos damos cuenta de la verdad en lo que Dios habla y nos abrimos al amor de Dios. Gradual y suavemente, Dios nos lleva de regreso a donde pertenecemos. Descubrimos nuevamente el carácter sagrado de la vida y la maravilla del poder de Dios. Con razón Lucas dirige sus comentarios a Teófilo. Es un nombre que significa "amado de Dios," un nombre que puede usar cualquier persona que desee la amistad con Dios.
