#### *Learn about Convalidation!*

A **Convalidation** is a celebration of the Sacrament of Matrimony in the Catholic Church. The only difference from any other sacramental marriage is the circumstance under which this marriage is being celebrated (for example, after a civil marriage ceremony has already taken place). It is not simply a renewal of vows or a blessing, but the creation of a valid marriage in the eyes of the Church.

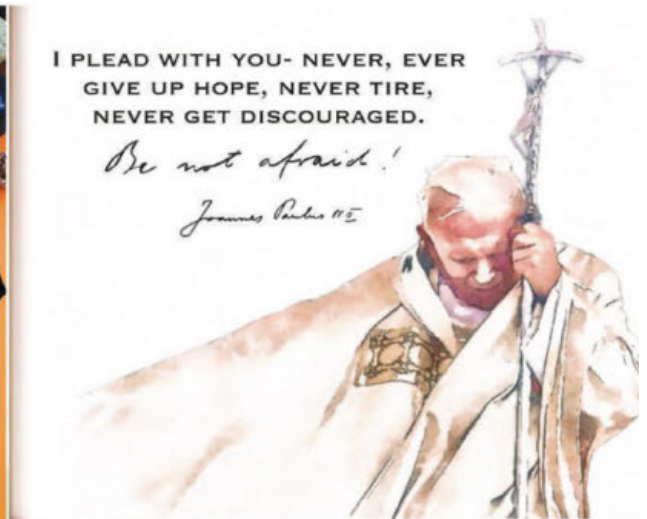

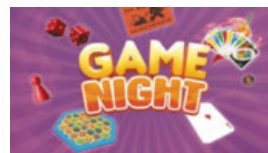

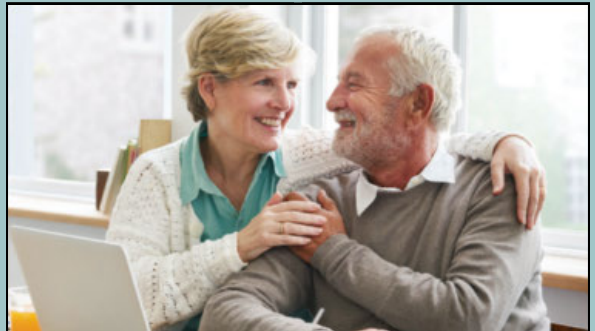
