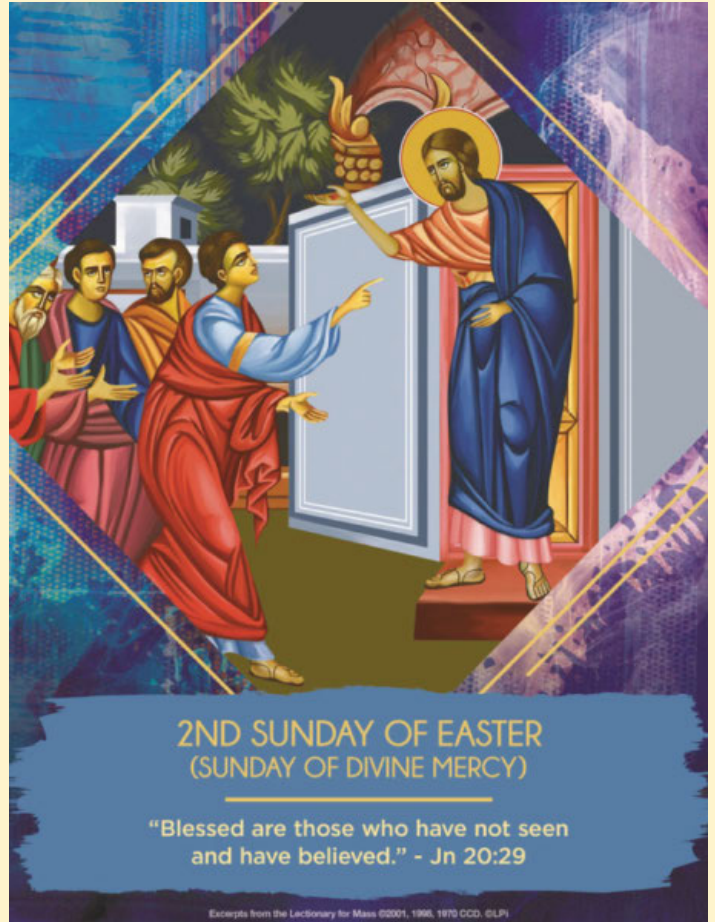

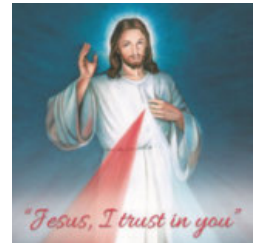
Mercy is the loving kindness and compassion shown to one who offends (i.e. the mercy of God to us sinners).

Pope John Paul II described early 1900s society as experiencing an “eclipse of the sense of God,” because mankind was losing the understanding of the sanctity and dignity of human life. In the 1930s, Jesus chose a Polish nun, St. Maria Faustina Kowalska, to receive revelations concerning Divine Mercy that she recorded in her diary.

In Pope Francis’ Homily given on the Feast of Divine Mercy in 2020, he reminded us of Jesus’ words to Saint Faustina by saying, “I am love and mercy itself; there is no human misery that could measure up to my mercy’ (*Diary, 14 September 1937*). At one time, the Saint, with satisfaction, told Jesus that she had offered him all of her life and all that she had. But Jesus’ answer stunned her: ‘You have not offered me the thing that is truly yours.’... Jesus said to her with kindness: ‘My daughter, give me your failings’” (*10 October 1937*).

Pope Francis continued, “We, too, can ask ourselves, ‘Have I given my failings to the Lord? Have I let him see me fall so that he can raise me up? Or is there something I still keep inside me? A sin, a regret from the past, a wound that I have inside, a grudge against someone, an idea about a particular person...’ The Lord waits for us to offer him our failings so that he can help us experience his mercy.”

In today’s gospel, Jesus institutes the Sacrament of Reconciliation for just this purpose. He knew we would be weak and that we would need recourse for sin. Having established Reconciliation, the apostles are sent forth, with the Holy Spirit, to continue sharing God’s unconditional love. And so are we.

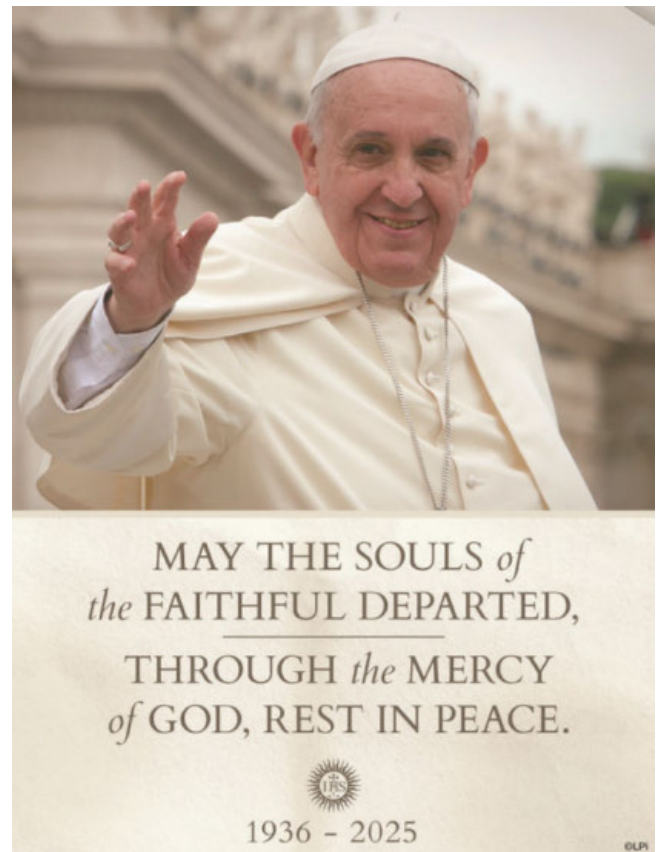

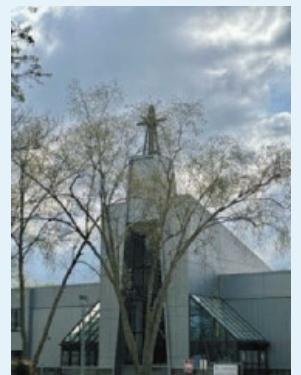

SOCIAL MINISTRY OUTREACH FOR MARCH

This month Social Ministry continued its mission to serve the poor.

- Food Pantry provided food and other essentials to 433 families; the food was valued at \$87,682.50
- \$2,210.55 was spent on food for the Food Pantry.
- Utilities or other assistance was provided to 58 families in the amount of \$9,738.85.
- Sandwich Ministry spent \$215.99 on food to prepare and deliver 208 sandwiches to Norfolk Catholic Worker twice this month to feed 104 homeless.
- Meals on Wheels delivered meals to the homebound the second week of the month.

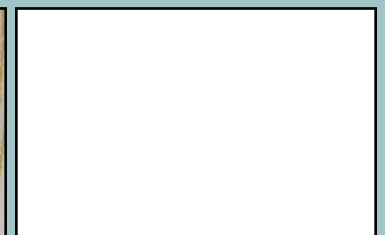
