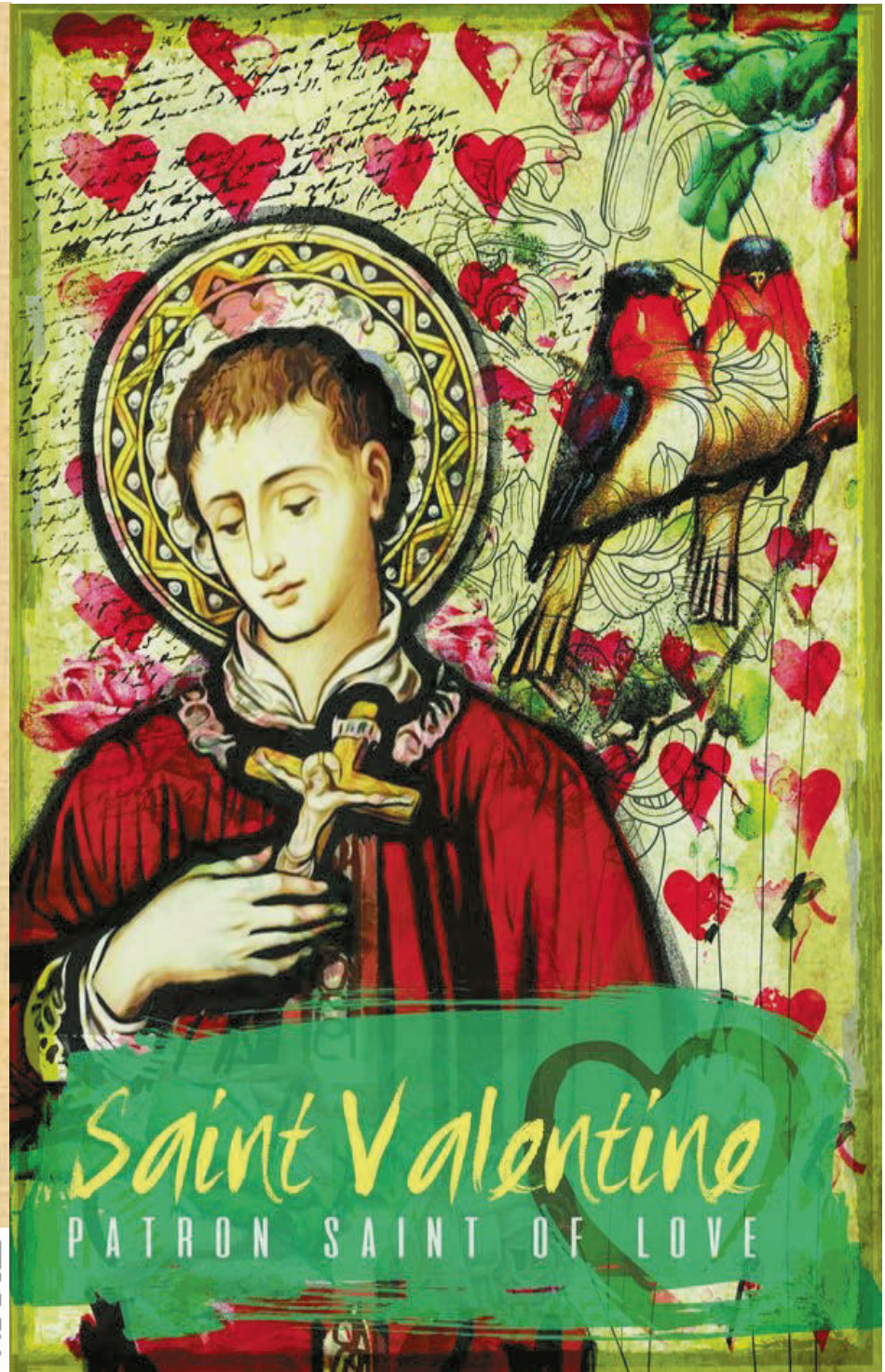

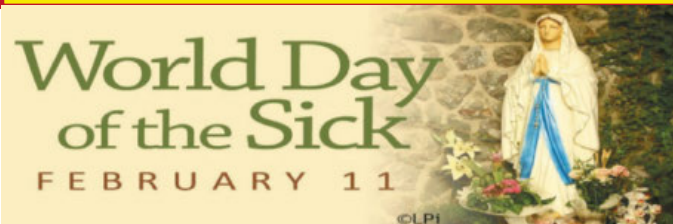

**FROM THE MUSIC DIRECTOR**

This Sunday, we celebrate the Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time. This will be the fourth week for our new mass ordinary setting, "The Mass of the Immaculate Conception." It may be found on page number 49 in the Source & Summit Missal. At the 10:30 mass, the choir's offertory motet will be "In The Year That King Uzziah Died" by Charles Wood. It is the text of the first reading, verbatim, which depicts a vision of the angels heaven in heaven proclaiming "Holy, Holy, Holy, is the Lord of hosts." The communion motet will be "Venite Comedite" by William Byrd, which translates to "Come eat my bread."

Next week, February 16, we will celebrate the Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time. The Gospel reading is the Sermon on the Mount, also known as the Beatitudes or the Proclamation of the Kingdom. At offertory, the choir will chant an arrangement of the Beatitudes from the Russian Orthodox Liturgy. The low bass notes that will be sung are typical in this style of composition. At communion the choir will sing Edward Elgar's setting of Ave Verum Corpus.

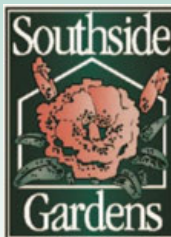
