

Perhaps you've heard the expression: **"It's either feast <u>or</u> famine."**

Well, this week it's going to be both ... *feast <u>and</u> famine*!

Yes, this Tuesday, March 1st is **Fat Tuesday.** And this Wednesday, March 2nd is **Ash Wednesday.**

As it does every year, **Ash Wednesday** marks the beginning of **the Penitential Season of Lent!**

Lent is that holy period of some 40 days where the Church guides us to take inventory of our soul by detaching ourselves from worldly concerns so as to make our soul right with God and with all the people around us.

A meaningful way to begin the Lenten Season is to receive ashes on your forehead on Ash Wednesday to remind you that our bodies will one day die and then decompose into nothing but ashes.

This <u>helps us to see</u> that taking care of **our mortal body** is <u>far less important than</u> taking care of **our immortal soul**, which never dies.

Yes, **our souls** <u>will live forever</u> **either** <u>with</u> God **or** <u>apart</u> <u>from</u> God ... based on the choices we make in this life.

Lent is **a special time** to make the changes we need to make to grow in holiness and be prepared to celebrate the Holiest of Days ... **Easter Sunday** ... on April 17th.

Here are **the Penitential Guidelines** everyone <u>should follow</u> on **Ash Wednesday** and on **each of the 7 Friday's of Lent**:

• <u>Abstain</u> from meat, and •<u>Fast</u> from food <u>by eating the equivalent of one meal</u>.

A powerful prayer to be prayed <u>during</u> Lent is the Stations of the Cross, where we spend time meditating on 14 Moments (called *Stations*) of Jesus' Passion and Crucifixion.

Please come pray **the Stations of the Cross** with us at **5:30 PM** on the **Fridays of Lent**.

After praying the **Friday Stations**, all are invited to come over to the **Parish Hall** to partake of a **meatless meal** prepared by members of **the Knights of Columbus** and **the Ladies Auxiliary**.

It's **a delicious Catfish meal** with trimmings made available at the price of **\$10 per person** or **\$30 per family** of 3 or more.

During Lent, please consider attending **6:45 AM Mass** weekdays in **Holy Spirit Church** and participate in the grace of **the "once for all Sacrifice"** of **Jesus on Calvary**.

And **Lent** would be a good time to begin <u>praying</u> the Daily Rosary!
