The 5 Dimensions to the Synod are:

Encountering

How do we encounter Jesus Christ? Where are you on the road to doing this in your life?

Listening

This is a process.

It involves "careful" listening, with any teaching to come later.

Discerning

What about those not directly connected with us? How do we decide between two or more good options?

Communion

This recognizes how we are the mystical body of Christ coming together with God and with each other.

Participation

Recognizing that this is not only a dialog... but a Trialogue ... with God ... with one another ... with all!

The Holy Spirit permeates this entire Process.

The challenging part of the process is ... Are we willing to see the Spirit's presence here?

The Synod gives us the chance to change the way we do things.

It will involve:

Asking, Listening, Assessing and Responding




How do I get involved?


