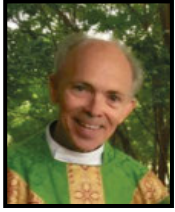

How do we decide between two or more good options?

Communion

This recognizes how we are the mystical body of Christ coming together with God and with each other.

Participation

Recognizing that this is not only a dialog...
but a Trialogue ...
with God ... with one another ... with all!

The Holy Spirit permeates this entire Process.

The challenging part of the process is ...
Are we willing to see the Spirit's presence here?

The Synod gives us the chance
to change the way we do things.

It will involve:
Asking, Listening, Assessing and Responding

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Recommended for all who are seriously ill or in danger of death. Contact the Parish Office.



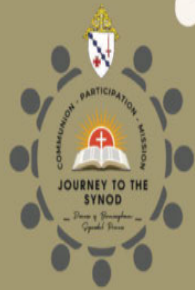


