FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



What's the ultimate goal of performing your penances this Lent?
It's simply this ...
"to be holy as the Lord your God is holy!"

Those were the words that God spoke to Moses long ago.

God's desire ... back then ... and to this very day is to form us in this life so that we're prepared to live with Him forever in Eternal Life .

And so yes, the goal of this Lent <u>actually is</u>: "Growing in Holiness"

This should be the foundational goal of our lives
... as we recognize our Baptismal calling ...
to grow in the Image and Likeness of Him, who is all-Holy.

Here are a few meditations to help you grow in Holiness.

Mother Angelica responded to a woman complaining of loneliness by suggesting, "If you're alone ... you're alone with God."

Think of what that means ... it means that **you're never alone** ... so rest in the nearness of God and enjoy His company!

St. Paul writes that, "Nothing can separate us from the love of God."

In other words, the Love of God is offered freely to everyone ... so, why not accept it?

The **greatest wound of Jesus** is <u>our</u> **pain**, the pain we bring ourselves when we choose not **Him** but sin.

For Jesus said,

"I came that you would have life and have it to the full."

How sad for us and Jesus when we choose something other than Him ... who is Life.

The reason why "growing in holiness"
often becomes more difficult as we get older is because
... as we get closer to God, we get to take the blinders off regarding our true holiness.

This can be **very humbling** for sure ... even **intimidating** ... but it's **the necessary way** of <u>transforming</u> **our souls** to be like Him ...and therefore ready to be in union with Him in Heaven.

The **reason we** move the Slider and spread the clingy sides of a Zip-Loc bag ... is to be able to put something inside the Zip-Loc bag.

In a similar way, God <u>stretches</u> us to be able to put something inside of us ... His Love!

Yes, I believe God is stretching us ... so He can fill us more completely with His love."

Wow! What a new and holy way to look at the times when we feel stretched to our limit.

That's likely the time when God is simply shaping us to be able to hold more of His love!

Please take these insights with you to prayer during these days of Lent. They're seeds for great meditation that will enable you to make great progress in God's universal call of:

"Growing in Holiness"






