FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Former President of the
United States, Ronald Reagan,
emphasized the fragileness of
our Democratic Freedom by
warning us that:
"We can lose our freedom
in one generation!"

Think about that!

Yes, if we fail to **love it** and **live it** and **pass it on** to our children ... our **beloved Freedom** can be lost in no time at all.

Well, that's not the only treasure that is fragile.

Another, even more precious treasure ... is our **Catholic Faith.**And it too, can be lost in one generation!

If you're reading this Bulletin today in either paper or electronic form, it's likely that you are "going to Church on Sunday" either in person or virtually on the TV or the Internet.

But what's so alarming is that ... there's a great number of people who aren't!

This came through two weeks ago as I heard the First Confessions of some 20 2nd Graders who hope to receive their First Holy Communion in May.

After stating their sins, <u>I would often ask them</u> if they were **going to Mass** or **viewing the Mass** on Sunday.

Sadly ... many of the children were not!

It seems many have **parents** who, for some reason, want them to receive their **First Communion** ...

but have no plans to get their children to their **Second, Third**, and **100**th **Communion** after that!

We <u>teach</u> our children in School and in Sunday School that "going to Church on Sunday" is required.

It's the 3rd Commandment of God and the only excuse for not attending Mass is if you're <u>sick</u> or <u>injured</u>.

Some of these kids knew this and some were in tears as they admitted that Mom and Dad don't go to Church or watch the Mass virtually.

I always reassure these kids that it's not their fault ... and I simply suggest that they remind their Parents that they need to go to Mass with them every Sunday.

It gets worse.

When I ask the children if they **pray before meals** at home ... **many** <u>say</u> **no**.

When I ask them if they **pray before bed** ... **many** say **no.**

And then you wonder why many young people today are not going to Church and have fallen away from their Faith.

It's because so many parents

<u>have not loved and lived and passed on</u>

the Catholic Faith to their children.

So please, pray for the graces of Lent to warm the hearts of those not practicing their Catholic Faith to return to ...

living it ... and loving it ... and handing it on!




Join us in the Parish Hall each Friday during Lent, following Stations of the Cross, for our Parish Fish Fry


