Going to Confession late in Lent not only prepares you for the worthy celebration of **the Great Day of Easter** ... but it <u>also prepares you</u> for the worthy celebration of **the Great Day of Divine Mercy**!

> Yes, back in the Jubilee Year of 2000, Pope John Paul II <u>declared</u> that the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Easter would <u>henceforth be celebrated</u> as Divine Mercy Sunday throughout the Universal Church.

With his authority as Vicar of Christ's Church, Pope John Paul II <u>declared</u> that all Catholics, who will go to Mass on Divine Mercy Sunday and <u>worthily receive</u> Holy Communion,

(having been to **Confession** (within 14 days before this and no serious sin since),

and <u>venerate</u> the image of the **Divine Mercy**, and <u>have</u> complete detachment from sin, <u>will receive</u> complete forgiveness of sins <u>and</u> punishment!

Oh, what a grace! It's a day we don't want to miss!

In addition to looking out for ourselves, let's also look out for others by constantly keeping the salvation of all souls in our prayers.

Let's continue to beseech God for the conversion of heart that will bring all people to come to know Him and love Him and serve Him.








STATIONS OF THE CROSS
