

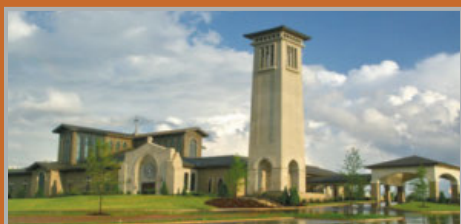

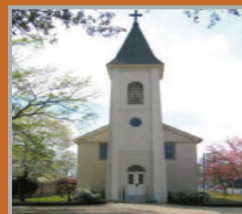

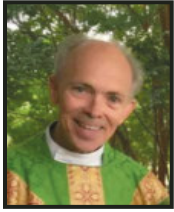

Here's a little Quiz from
"The Pastor's Desk"
 I wrote 2 weeks ago.

Why did God establish Tithing?

1. So we're sure to **thank Him** for the income we receive from our labors.
2. So we're able to **sustain our Church**.

Perhaps you recalled **the Acronym** I made up for **Tithing**:
Transfer **I**ncome **T**o **H**im **I**n **N**ever-ending **G**ratitude!

Yes, **the reasons for Tithing include ...**
Showing our Gratitude and **providing our Support**:

The **Catholic model for Tithing might look like this**:

- Give **5%** of your income to your **Parish**
- Give **1%** of your income to the **Diocese**
 (Catholic Charities & Communities)
- Give **4%** to the **Charities** of your choice.

This totals 10% of your income given to God!

Hopefully you've received your **Personal Pledge Card**
 in the mail and spent some time in prayer / reflection
 to assess how you plan to do **your tithing in 2023**.

There are 57 apostolates and ministries
 that receive and distribute
 the money given to Catholic Charities.

While all you need to do is **pledge** at this time ...
 you may certainly attach a **full** or **partial payment**
 if you wish.

And you may also choose to **be billed monthly**
in 2023 for your pledge.

You may bring your **Personal Pledge Card**
 with you to **Mass** or **fill out a blank one** in the pew
 and place it in the **Offertory basket** on any Sunday.

Many people now choose to make a **Pledge / Payment**
on - line through our **Diocese of Birmingham Web Site**.

A good many people choose to make a **Pledge / Payment**
by mailing it in to the **Diocese of Birmingham**.

Regardless of how you make your Pledge/ Payment,

 is showing your gratitude to God for **His blessings**
 and is providing your support for **His Church**.
