CAPUCHIN MISSION APPEAL

FR. STEVE RODRIGUES

Dear friends! Greetings of Peace and joy!

It feels very good to be back at MERCY and in Baton Rouge! I thank Fr. Cleo Milano for the warm invitation he sent to me to help out at your parish, "a sanctuary" I would say, where people come in numbers from all over the diocese especially for the Sacrament of Reconciliation! In Fr. Cleo's email to me he said, "your room is ready, come," so it took me no time to book my ticket and take the flight, even with the hazards COVID has placed on traveling.

The Covid-19 pandemic in India has been horrific. Thousands died, millions suffered, and many were displaced. Over 300 priests and nuns were swallowed up by the ferocious disease. My beautiful state, Goa, was worst hit among all the other states in India. The hospitals were filled to capacity - the shortage of beds, vaccines, oxygen and other medicines severely affected the survival rate. People were battling for life with dreadful fear and loneliness. The sound of weeping and wailing prevailed all over the area. Death was all around, with bodies continuously being wrapped up and taken straight for burial and families missing funeral services most of the time. There were also shortages of doctors and nurses as they too were dying while rendering remarkable medical services. They battled against all odds and worked around the clock, to bring solace and comfort to patients who were gasping for life. They were the courageous warriors, 'Angels of God' who risked their lives to keep many people alive.

In Goa, we lost a young talented Capuchin priest, age 40, and some of the Capuchins were placed on ventilators. The Divine Mercy of God kept many of us alive. I prayed daily to Our Lady of Mercy asking her to keep all of you and me safe. I told the Lord: "Lord, don't take me away. I want to serve you and your people for many more years." This being the situation, many of us Capuchins went out of our way to help the needy and dying: celebrating sacraments, counseling, groceries, etc. We stormed heaven, prayed before the Blessed Sacrament in Eucharistic Adoration, prayed novenas, and offered Holy Mass, asking the Lord to take control of the situation. The Lord heard our prayers: Churches are now opening, people can move around, schools are opened etc. To help the people in their desperation, the Capuchins have always been the good Samaritans. Seeing the pathetic Covid situation, 12 fine young men have come forward to carry forward the mission of Christ. I personally invite people of goodwill to help my Capuchin Order to help those less fortunate to recuperate from their Covid-19 shock. "Be a rainbow in someone's cloud." Your generous help will go a long way to:

- Support 12 seminarians (directly under my care): to build a classroom for them, buy books for seminary library, and a keyboard for the Seminary.
- Help to Educate around 50 young children who have lost both of their parents due to Covid-19
- Help the orphans and very poor families in our village

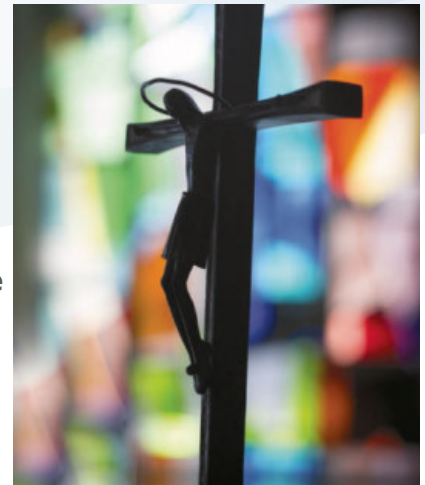

Anointing of the sick gives spiritual strength and healing to those who are aged or ill. It is no longer "extreme unction," given only to those in danger of death. It can be received any time during illness. Parishes conduct communal anointings to show a compassionate solidarity with the sick and to experience and celebrate corporately the healing presence of Christ. [1499-1532]

The Sacrament of the Sick for healing of mind, body, and soul will be offered on Wednesday, June 15th following 12:00 noon Holy Mass. If you are presently ill with any disease; preparing or recovering from surgery; undergoing cancer treatment; anxiety; eating disorder; addiction of any kind; diseases of the eyes; experience grief or depression, you are invited to receive God's healing grace on **WEDNESDAY, JUNE 15th following 12:00 noon Holy Mass.**

The Oil of the Sick is blessed by the Bishop at the Chrism Mass and is used to anoint the forehead and the palms.

"Through this Holy Anointing - May the Lord in His love and mercy help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit. May the Lord who frees you from sin, raise you up on the last day."
