FATHER BROWN'S SUNDAY NOTES...

On 9 January 2011, Pope Benedict XVI baptized 21 infants in the Sistine Chapel. It was the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. **A remark he made became headline news through the world when he reminded Catholic parents that they should be choosing Christian names for their children. The choice of a name reinforces and communicates to the child as he or she grows "the essential realities of the Sacrament of Baptism and the Christian Life". One of the first and most long-lasting gifts parents give to a child is a name.** This is the way that the child will be referred to for the rest of his or her life.

A name is not just for a birthday, but for a lifetime and actually, for our eternal life as well. We know from Sacred Scripture how seriously God valued names when he changed the names in the Old Testament from Abram to Abraham, Sarai to Sarah, and Jacob to Israel. In the New Testament, Jesus changed Simon's name to Peter. The naming of a child is significant and should not be done thoughtlessly or casually. Please consider our Catholic faith and choose names that reflect our belief. It can be a powerful reminder to that child as he or she grows up!

The Baptism of the Lord is celebrated today at all Masses except for the Traditional Latin Mass which celebrates the Feast on Thursday, January 13th. The 11 am Mass today is for the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, & Joseph.

- ***Consider becoming a part of the Legion of Mary...*** which is an easy way to truly live our Catholic faith. Not only will you be inspired to more prayer, you also will find yourself wanting to be engaged with apostolic work. **After all of the Masses today, there will be a representative from the Legion of Mary available to answer any questions you may have about becoming an associate member.** I strongly support the Legion of Mary and encourage you to consider membership.
- ***I have come to look forward...***to the second and fourth Sundays of the month when we have our After Mass Sunday Social! **Come downstairs to the Marian Lounge anytime between 7 am and 1 pm TODAY and enjoy some delicious food that almost always connects to our liturgical season!** Thank you to the AMSS Committee for their continued enthusiasm and good work!
- ***The Confraternity of the Holy Rosary...***meets **TO-DAY at 10 am in the Chapel. Our monthly Holy Rosary Procession will be at 10:25 am, weather permitting.** Dress warmly if we do go outside. Otherwise, we will remain inside and join the congregation for the regularly scheduled Holy Rosary. New members are always welcome at our meetings and you do not need to be a member to join us for the Holy Rosary Procession.
- ***Welcome back to our CCD students...***who **return to classes today at 9:30 am. Remember that if you are the parent or caregiver of a child enrolled in public or charter schools, you should enroll him or her in CCD classes.** It's easy to enroll. Stop in to the MQP School Office this morning to learn more.
- ***Because of the spike in illnesses...***the MQP Seniors Luncheon Meeting scheduled for Wednesday, January 12th has been canceled. In addition, our Annual Burgers & Beer planned for Saturday, January 29th has been canceled based upon recommendations from the Diocese of Cleveland. If you have bought tickets, please call the Rectory for a refund. Finally, Bishop Malesic had wanted to visit each of the Parish Districts in the Diocese with a Mass and a Reception. Bishop Malesic has chosen to cancel those Masses and Receptions. **Our District is Cleveland Northwest and we had planned to partner with Cleveland West for a joint Mass and Rehearsal. It was previously scheduled for Sunday, January 30th at Saint Mark in West Park. It has been canceled.** Thanks for your understanding during these strange days.
- ***A Free Throw Competition...***for youth ages 9 to 14 will be held on Thursday, January 13th from 2 to 4 pm in the Parish Center Gym. Winners in each age group will advance to regional competition. It is helpful, but not necessary, if you register in advance by calling the Rectory or School.
- ***It's not Lent yet...***so why not support MQP School by purchasing a candy bar (or two) in our Annual Candy Bar Sale. **It begins on Friday, January 14th and proceeds go to support high school scholarships for our graduating students!**
- ***Our next FREE Community Meal...***will be on Sunday, January 16th. **Doors to the Parish Center Cafeteria open at 12 Noon. Please do not come any earlier to the Community Meal unless you are planning to attend the 11 am Mass. Otherwise, arrive at 12 Noon. Meals are served inside from 1 to 1:30 pm. Drive-through meals are served outside from 1:30 to 2 pm. Please do not line up in your cars any earlier than 1:15 pm. Only one meal per person will be offered.** Thank you for your cooperation with these requirements. Anyone who does not follow the expectations for the Community Meal will not be invited to attend in the future.
- ***We have seen a decline in interest...***for the Blue Army Holy Hour which is held on the Third Sunday of each month at 2 pm in the Church. I had a conversation recently with those who coordinate the Holy Hour and they asked me if I thought it was worth continuing. I said that any time of prayer that includes devotion to Our Blessed Mother and the Holy Rosary is worth our time, especially for the unseen graces showered upon our parish. Please support the Blue Army Holy Hour if you are able. **The next Blue Army Holy Hour will be on Sunday, January 16th at 2 pm.**
- ***It has been said that...***the 1948 film *Joan of Arc* was a "dream project" for its star Ingrid Bergmann, who lobbied to have it made for many years. She even starred in a Broadway production of *Joan of Arc*. Come see this outstanding move about the life of the famous French saint, who led the French in battle against the English at Orleans during the Hundred Years War – all at the age of 18! ***Joan of Arc* is our next selection for Catholic Movie Night on Sunday, January 16th beginning at 6 pm.** This is one of our longer selections at two hours and 25 minutes. It sometimes helps to bring something soft to sit on. As always, refreshments will be available.

- **The Mobile Food Pantry...** is moved to Saturday, January 22nd, which is the fourth Saturday of the month and is one week later than usual, because the Cleveland Foodbank is closed for the weekend of the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. civil holiday. Adjust your calendars to show that the next **Mobile Food Pantry, which distributes over 10,000 pounds of fresh produce, will be on Saturday, January 22nd from 9 to 11 am.** It remains a drive-through process.
- **The Old Brooklyn Crime Watch meeting...** has turned out to be a great group of people who are truly intent on making our neighborhood a better place to live and work. You are welcome to come to the next **OBCW on Wednesday, January 26th at 7 pm in the Parish Center Upper Hall.**
- **Always timely...** is the **Annual Blessing of Throats offered near the Feast Day of Saint Blaise. The Blessing of Throats will be after the January 29th Vigil Mass and all Masses on January 30th.**

With an increase in COVID-19 cases of the Omicron variant, **I suggest that you please call the Rectory before coming to the parish for a meeting or event. You can also check our Facebook and Instagram pages. If Masses would have to be canceled, you would receive notification from our E-Blast, for which you may sign up on our website.
