FATHER BROWN'S SUNDAY NOTES...

As we enter into these summer months, the pace always seems to slow down some and for that I am grateful. With more hours of daylight and warmer weather, it is the perfect chance to have a little extra time to do some of the things that maybe you did not get around to doing in the winter months - when you are rushing to work, running errands, getting the kids up and running, or even with homeschooling – whatever takes up your mornings, maybe you have a little more time now. With that extra time I cannot think of a better way to start your day than attending daily Mass. We have two Masses Monday through Friday. Join us at sunrise for a Traditional Latin Low Mass at 6:15 am. At 8 am, we have an English Mass and afterwards, there are Confessions, and a faithful group prays the Holy Rosary.

Going to daily Mass is a beautiful way to enrich your own spiritual life. In his recent book entitled *The Catholic Mass: Steps to Restore the Centrality of God in the Liturgy*, Bishop Athanasius Schneider writes about the Mass as a source of salvation:

"...through the celebration of each Holy Mass the most sublime act of adoration and thanksgiving is offered to God. IT IS THE ACT MOST PLEASING TO GOD, THE MOST HOLY TRINITY [emphasis mine]. Moreover, each celebration of the Holy Mass applies the spiritual fruits emanating from the sacrifice of the Cross to a specific time and place, and to specific persons and intentions."

What beautiful words for this Trinity Sunday reminding us that Holy Mass is the act most pleasing to God. Of all that we do to serve God, attending Holy Mass is THE most pleasing thing we could do! Know of my strongest encouragement to attend Holy Mass daily. Start going once or twice or week and you will see a change to your day!

- A CHANGE in location...for the After Mass Sunday Social TODAY as the morning crew move temporarily to the Parish Center upstairs. The After Mass Sunday Social Committee want to make it easy for YOU to attend the Shroud of Turin Exhibit this morning in the Upper Hall of the Parish Center from 8 am to 1 pm. Come and get a cup of coffee and something good to eat and learn more about the miraculous Shroud of Turin! The AMSS runs from 7 am to 1 pm.
- of the Second Sunday of every month...the Confraternity of the Holy Rosary meets for their monthly meeting at 10 am in the Chapel (lower church). Our meetings are brief, but informative. At approximately 10:30 am, we meet on the upper deck of the church for our Holy Rosary Procession around the parish grounds. We stop at various spots dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary, and offer her our own petitions and prayers for she is our greatest intercessor in Heaven.
- At our last meeting of Old Brooklyn Crime Watch we talked a lot about the "dirt bike" problem...in the City of Cleveland over the past year. It seems that the city is now taking a different approach to this issue, and I would like to think that some of the conversation at our last meeting helped clarify the concerns. Please join us for the next Old Brooklyn Crime Watch Meeting on Wednesday, June 15th at 7 pm in the Parish Center Upper Hall. Meetings

- last only an hour and representatives from the City as well as the Second District are always present.

The Mobile Food Pantry is on Saturday, June 18th from 9 am to 11 am.
- The Mass of Confirmation...for our Eighth Graders and a couple of adults will be on Saturday, June 18th at the 4:30 pm Vigil Mass. The Sacrament of Confirmation is the last Sacrament of Initiation and is required to be a godparent for Baptism or sponsor for Confirmation as well as it is strongly encouraged in order to be married in the Catholic Church. I applaud these young people for taking the time to receive this most important Sacrament.
- Our 13th Annual Corpus Christi Procession...will be on Sunday, June 19th after the 11 am Mass. Because there are some differences between the liturgical calendar for the Traditional Latin Mass and the Novus Ordo, Corpus Christi is actually celebrated on the previous Thursday. However, a general permission is offered to be able to celebrate Corpus Christi as an "external solemnity" which we will do on Sunday, June 19th. It allows us to have the most people involved in the Corpus Christi Procession which has been a highlight of our spiritual activities. Following the Corpus Christi Procession is the Famous Hot Dog Social sponsored by the Holy Name Society.
- As a reminder...the Holy Name Society meets on the Third Tuesday of each month at 7 pm in the Parish Center, though you may find them meeting outside if the weather is nice! The Holy Name Society is looking for new members, especially those who may be able to assist us with the Annual "Stuff the Bus" campaign. Let me know of your interest or just plan to come to the meeting to learn more. The next Holy Name Society meeting is Tuesday, June 21st at 7 pm.
- Father's Day is...Sunday, June 19th. We have everything you need for dad or grandpa or uncle or big brother or even husband! We are selling gift cards in the Main Vestibule of the Church after Masses. We have Father's Day Intentions Cards in the Main Vestibule of the Church to pick up at any time. We also have a great variety of MQP sportswear!
- The FREE Community Meal...is on Sunday, June 19th. We are always looking for groups or families that would like to sponsor a Community Meal. It costs approximately \$400 to sponsor an entire meal or you can purchase the food and prepare it, which could cost less. Either way, it's a great opportunity to help our neighborhood! - A pleasant afternoon of peace awaits you...at the Blue Army Holy Hour on Sunday, June 19th at 2 pm in the church. Prayers and devotions to Our Lady of Fatima

are offered.

• In this month devoted to the Sacred Heart of Jesus...the Feast of the Sacred Heart is on Friday, June 24th. To celebrate this feast day, we will have a special Latin Low Mass at 7 pm in the church. If there are some that would like to help organize a social afterwards, please let me know.

Can you help out those in need in our neighborhood? Our Saint Vincent de Paul Society tirelessly offers food and other forms of assistance throughout the Old Brooklyn neighborhood. Your monthly donations of groceries are most helpful to those facing food insecurity. In addition, your monetary contributions also help the Saint Vincent de Paul Society assist others with rent and utility needs, which continue to increase. If you could offer a monetary gift during these summer months, it would be much appreciated! The Saint Vincent de Paul Society Third Sunday Collection is NEXT weekend. Please help if you can.

Speaking of Saint Vincent de Paul, in these summer months, we see a lot more people walking around our neighborhood and in our parking lots. Recently, we have had a couple of people who have been very persistent in asking for assistance – particularly money. I have talked to these individuals and offered help through our Saint Vincent de Paul Society, which they have refused. I ask that you do not give them any monetary assistance and instead refer them to our Saint Vincent de Paul Society for help. One only needs to call the main number to the Rectory and there is an option to leave a message for Saint Vincent de Paul. Our local Vincentians check the messages regularly and will return the call to assess the assistance needed. 




