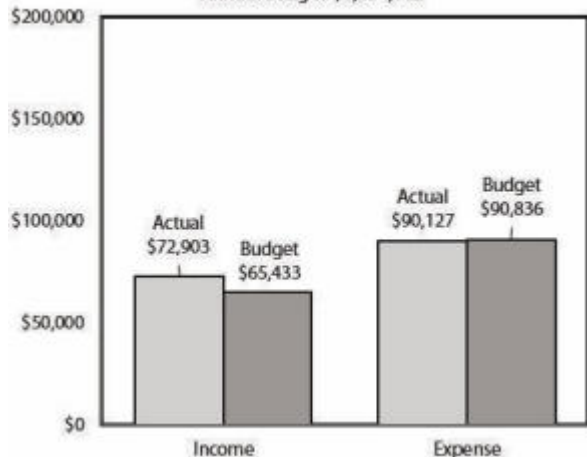

# FINANCIAL UPDATE

## Fiscal Year-to-Date Financial Report

July 1 - 31, 2020

Annual budget \$1,334,682



- Total income for the first month of the fiscal year was \$72,903, over budget by \$7,470 due to generous gifts in response to the spring newsletter. Income was \$10,338 less than July 2019, due to a decrease in program fees received. These program fees should “catch up” in August and September.
- Expenses in July were as anticipated for the month, totaling \$90,127. Expenses were \$5,831 higher than July 2019 due to filled staff positions and the replacement of essential equipment.
- The net loss for July was \$17,223; less than budgeted by \$8,180.
- The unrestricted cash balance at July 31 was \$456,936. The receipt in April of \$145,000 in loan proceeds under the Paycheck Protection Program significantly increased the cash balance. A substantial portion of the loan funds were necessary to support this year’s budget. Details of the Small Business Administration loan can be found on the Finances page at **BuckeyCatholic.com**. To fund operations, approximately \$120,000 per month is needed. Our goal is to maintain a cash reserve balance equal to three months’ expenses, approximately \$360,000.

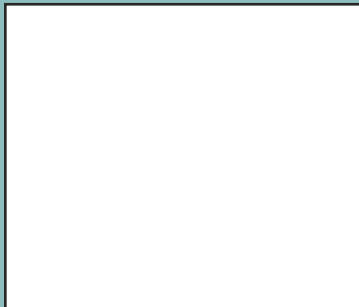
