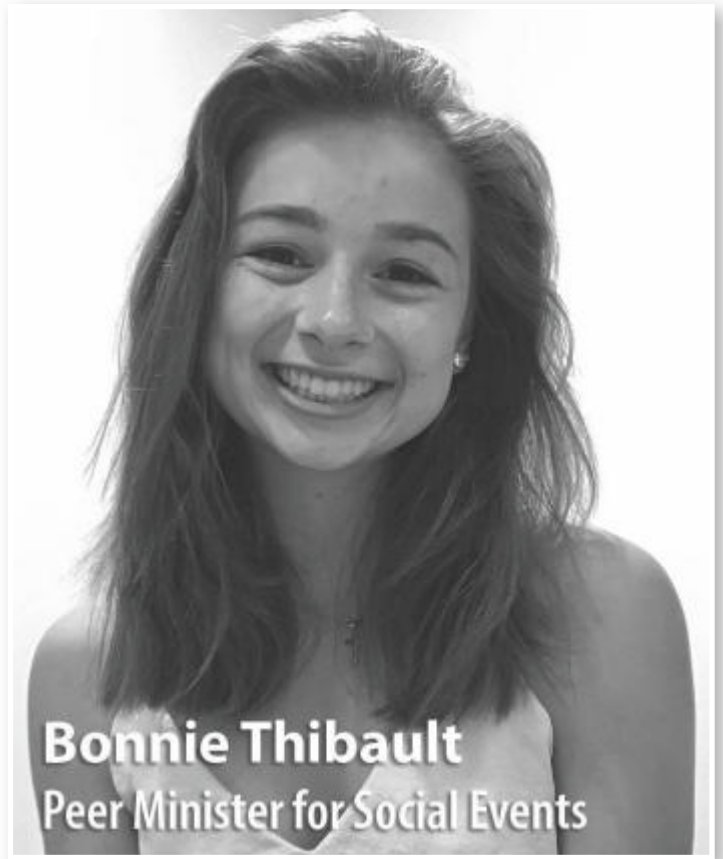

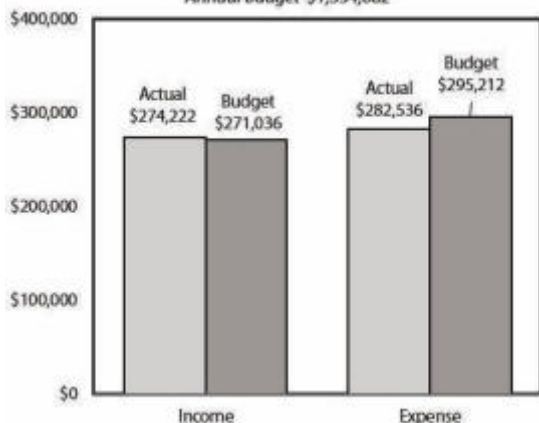

FINANCIAL UPDATE

Fiscal Year-to-Date Financial Report

July 1 - Sept. 30, 2020

Annual budget \$1,334,682



September was a quiet month with favorable budget variances in both income and expense. Year-to-date variances were favorable as well, leading to a net loss of \$8,314. On a positive note, the loss was \$15,862 less than the budgeted loss of \$24,176 at this point in the fiscal year.

- Total income was slightly over budget at \$274,222. Gifts of over \$48,000 were received in August from the Columbus Foundation's "Big Give" fund raising event held in June. These donations from Newman Center supporters substantially boosted current year-to-date income and significantly increased income over the same time last year
- Total expenses in September continued the favorable trend of falling just short budget. Expenses year-to-date were \$282,536, under budget by \$12,676 with a modest decrease compared to last year.
- The unrestricted cash balance on Sept. 30 was \$470,606. The receipt in April of \$145,000 in loan proceeds under the Paycheck Protection Program significantly increased the cash balance. A substantial portion of the loan funds were necessary to support this year's budget. Details of the Small Business Administration loan can be found at BuckeyCatholic.com/finances. To fund operations, approximately \$120,000 per month is needed. Our goal is to maintain a cash reserve balance equal to three months' expenses, approximately \$360,000.

We are deeply grateful for all the ways our community supports the Newman Center - financial, in prayer and in service to Catholic campus ministry at The Ohio State University.

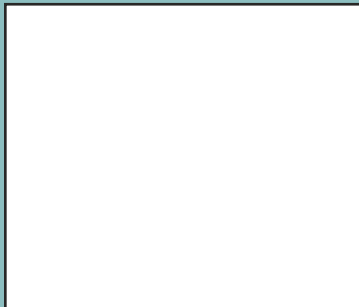
