

Dear Parishioners and Friends: Happy New Year! Once again, I would like to thank all of our parishioners, those who decorated the churches, and all who were involved with ministry in any way during this Christmas season, with readings, musicians, and anyone who helped make everything run

smoothly. I also thank everyone for their generosity to me and to the parish during the Christmas season.

Today ends "officially" our Christmas season, those who wish, may once again receive the Sacrament of the Sick, if you feel comfortable in doing so. With Covid still hovering around, it may not be a bad thing. All elderly parishioners, those suffering from any illness (including having had covid) are welcome to receive the Sacrament of the Sick. Please know we will leave the Christmas decorations up in our churches for the next few weeks. Please mark your Calendars for a Special Mass and the Blessing of Candles on February 1st at 6:00pm at St. Jude Church. Everyone should have a blessed candle in your home. You are welcome to bring candles that you buy in the store, and we will bless the candles we will use in our churches during the year.

I don't want to start the year off sadly, but many of you heard that my longtime friend, Msgr. Bill Bonczewski from Our Lady of Lebanon passed away, shortly before Christmas. Also please remember in your prayers Fr. Frederick Lukehart, a retired priest of our Diocese who passed away, and was buried last week.

Msgr. Bill didn't have to die, but our Lord was ready for him. He was a wonderful, saintly priest, whom I have had the pleasure of knowing for many years. He was Rector of the Shrine when I was first ordained a priest. I've always helped at their Assumption Pilgrimage. I not only help, but I go as a pilgrim myself. It is hard to believe that I will be a priest 27 years this year. As Judy Collins would sing:

"Where has all the time gone?" In all of those years, I have learned, sometimes with great sadness, that nothing lasts forever, at least here on this earth. Over these many years, I have rarely missed a pilgrimage at the Shrine. While I may not be able to participate all three days, I at least go one day.

I would like to begin this New Year with a reflection by Thomas Merton(1915-1968). For our younger people who may not know who Thomas Merton was. He was one of the most prolific spiritual writers of the 20th Century. A convert to Catholicism, he entered the Trappist monastery Gethsemane outside of Louisville, Kentucky, in 1941. The author of more than sixty books and hundreds of articles and poems. Merton's most acclaimed book is his spiritual autobiography, "*The Seven Story Mountain.*" Following my letter is his prayer for your enjoyment as we begin this New Year.

> Make it a good week! Father David, Priest & Sinner

My Lord God, I have no idea where I am going, I do not see the road ahead of me. I cannot know for certain where it will end. Nor do I really know myself, and the fact that I think I am following your will does not mean that I am actually doing so.

But I believe that the desire to please you does in fact please you.

And I hope that I will never do anything apart from that desire.

And I know that if I do this you will lead me by the right road, though I may know nothing about it.

Therefore I will trust you always though I may seem to be lost and in the shadow of death. I will not fear, for you are ever with me,

and you will never leave me to face my perils alone.

Please note that we will have the installation of both new parish council members and finance council members from St. Jude Parish this January & February when we start a new term. We thank all mem-



bers of both councils who have served six years or longer, but it is the policy of the Diocese to always have new members be a part of the councils.

New members of Our Lady of Lourdes Councils who were chosen late last year will also be installed when we have our meetings at the parish respectively.
