

HOUSEHOLD OF GOD

Dear Parishioners and Friends:

There will be Eucharistic Adoration in St. Jude Church on Friday, January 21st, to mark the somber anniversary of legalized abortion in this country. We will have adoration all day in the church from 9:00am-9:00pm. Please sign up for a

specific hour so that the Blessed Sacrament is never left alone. Also advise and please invite parishioners and friends from our neighboring parishes who would like to make a holy hour. Pro-life materials will be available in back of the church.

I like to use my column for teaching, many times concerning practices or rituals of our Church. A couple of months ago I wrote why eulogies and words of remembrance are not permitted during the funeral Mass itself. I would like to continue to expound on this because I think it is important that people have an understanding why this isn't permitted during the funeral Mass.

Fr. Czeslaw Krysa is the Director of Worship and also Rector of St. Casimir Church in Buffalo, New York. I would like to share with you his writings on this particular subject. I will continue this series for a few weeks.

How many times have you heard funeral directors announce in church, "We're here to celebrate the life of...."? I've even heard priests use this phrase. Does the Catholic Church celebrate the life of a dead person?

Absolutely not! To the contrary, the Catholic Funeral Mass celebrates the Life and Resurrection of Jesus, without whom the funeral is mere hocus-pocus. Yes, without the Risen Christ, a funeral Mass is just *pro forma* an inward belly button gazing at our losses.

First and foremost, the Requiem Eucharistic celebrates the passion, execution, and Resurrection victory of Jesus (without Him there is no life after death). Therefore celebrating Jesus' personal victory over human ignorance, hatred of the crowd, and mass violence against God Himself opens eternal celestial doors to each Baptized person.

The funeral Mass does not celebrate the dead! It does not look backward. It is not a nostalgic picture of whom we lost. With the saints of the ages around the Lord's Eucharistic altar, we gather at the Wedding Feast of the Lamb of God in heaven. We are there to pray that God forgive the sins of the deceased person and release and purify him/her from any remnant of unforgiven sin and punishment for them--the essence of purgatory.

This is why eulogies are not a part of the Catholic funeral Mass. Eulogies focus on the past, the Mass focuses on our future, our eternity with Jesus. Through Him, we gain unending lift. For a believer, nothing is lost at death. All is gain. Yes, eulogies (despite the fact we have all heard them), are totally foreign to a funeral Mass.
