Where do eulogies belong? (Part 2 of 3) Dear fellow mountain-climbers of the Lord:

I would like to continue the important matter of why eulogies are not to be given during a funeral Mass. "A brief homily based on the readings is to be given...there is never to be a eulogy." (n.27). This is

found in the Order of Christian Funerals.

Fr. Czeslaw Krysa, Former Director of Worship for the Diocese of Buffalo, and Rector of St. Casimir Church in Buffalo, has written extensively on this subject. Eulogies have snuck into Catholic Funeral Masses, mimicking secular funerals for politicians and heads of state. They exemplify a protestant-ized Catholic Mass as many Reformed Churches can be likened to a "Sunday-go-to" meeting hall.

Protestants (and some Catholics) enter a church without genuflecting toward the Tabernacle of the Blessed Sacrament. (I know in some Catholic churches, you don't know where the tabernacle is!) They neither bless, nor sign themselves with holy water; there's no kneeling, silence, or lighting vigil candles. They find or are led to a seat by an usher. Sometimes they are given a program, like an agenda.

Conversations ensue until meetings start. Some Catholics copy these non-prayerful behaviors before Mass, minimalizing the sacredness of the place. Unfortunately, this seems to be happening more and more, as we deal with so many unchurched people, and people who just do not know how to behave in a church. A meeting hall atmosphere ensues until the opening hymn interrupts the talking. Unfortunately, I've already had experiences where people continue to talk throughout the Mass.

When Catholic Mass is experienced as a meeting, it's no surprise that speakers, unordained people are admitted to the pulpit to give opinions, to give presentations, or even eulogies. It's more interpersonal gathering, than worshiping God. It's more about us, less about God, and more a secular or pagan memorial fest (funeral).

If this message upsets your apple cart, draw comfort from traditional Catholic funeral practices. Eulogies have a proper place, but not during Mass, nor in Church. According to venerable custom, memories of the deceased are reserved for the cemetery or mausoleum. If the weather is inclement, perhaps at the luncheon after.




