Where do eulogies belong? (Part 3 of 3) Dear fellow mountain-climbers of the Lord:

This is the last in a series of reflections from Fr. Czeslaw Krysa, Former Director of Worship of the Diocese of Buffalo, and Rector of St. Casimir Church in Buffalo.

Did you know the purpose of a Roman Catholic funeral is to lead the person (their mortal remains, as Temples of the Holy Spirit) to burial, and their soul to paradise?

The Catholic Funeral is one heaven-ward procession with three stops: (1) the Funeral Home, (in past times it was the place of death), (2) the Lord's Eucharistic altar in Church, (3) the final resting place or grave. The Mass distinguishes the Catholic funeral from the Protestant funeral or secular memorial services. St. Augustine understood the Funeral Mass as true, eternal "refreshment" in "the breaking of the Bread" for the deceased. The primary focus is Jesus, not the dead person.

Burial is a time to come face-to-face with earthly death (literally) and to *begin* the memorializing of your beloved deceased. Making memorial of a deceased person flows *from* the funeral Mass. It is not its content. Holy remembrance, according to Catholic spirituality, take places annually with an anniversary Mass and family meal.

The first memorial follows the Funeral Mass at the cemetery. It may continue at the funeral luncheon and it is followed by life-long mementos, or "good words" (the original meaning of eulogy) about the deceased. Catholic remembrance, therefore, is not limited to one-time words or a speech at a funeral.

While eulogies are not part of a funeral Mass (the quote from the Rite of Catholic Funerals), remembering deceased friends and relatives is not at all limited to the funeral. It usually starts at table during the funeral luncheon, and hopefully is repeated at least annually on the anniversary of a death. For the baptized, relationships do not end at death.

Celebrate living *thanksgiving* for those who loved you, whom you dearly miss. Don't be afraid of tears. Tears of love release toxins from your body and purify your blood. They chemically differ from tears of despair and anxiety.

Get healthier, stronger, and more resilient; not through bellybutton regrets over what you've lost or through self-pity. Celebrate Jesus' life-restoring Resurrection first; and then discuss, share, and remember all that is good. That's the living (not dead) eulogy of a misunderstood funeral Mass.


FEAST OF CANDLEMAS





There is more confusion over this sacrament than Confirmation. Anointing of the Sick is NOT a "get out of jail free card." Grandpa hasn't been to church in 45 years, so let's dab his head with oil "just in case"! No, it doesn't work that way. Unfortunately people will die without being anointed. As our numbers in the priesthood decline, this will happen. However, I am your priest, and it doesn't have to happen. If a loved one is sick, please call us at the office so arrangements can be made. This is also one reason why I have begun anointings at Mass periodically.




