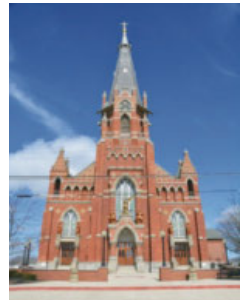
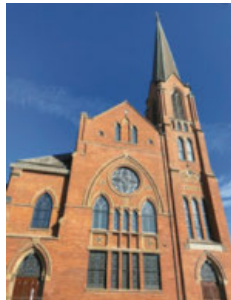

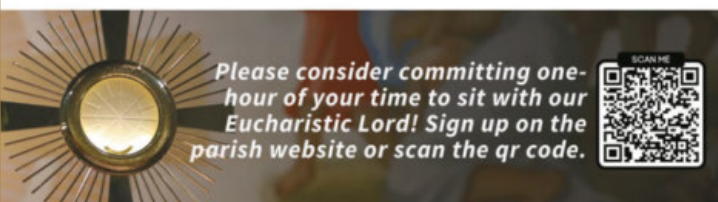

VICAR'S CORNER: FR. ALEX BIRYOMUMEISHO

WEALTH AND ATTACHMENT: A REFLECTION ON MARK 10:17-30



Perhaps we have all struggled with attachments. Sometimes, we don't realize what they are until God calls us to do something, and we suddenly feel, "I can't give that up." For me, this realization came in 2014 when I moved from Uganda to Mount St. Mary's Seminary of the West in Cincinnati. I missed my family and friends deeply, and adjusting to a new country, culture, language, and way of life was a real test of my commitment to follow Jesus. There were days when I thought about leaving everything and returning to Uganda. But by God's grace, I reflected on the "miraculous" moments that had led me to the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, and I stayed. Now, I am grateful that I did.

In Mark 10:17-30, Jesus encounters a young man who also faces a moment of attachment. He has kept the commandments, but when Jesus asks him to give up his wealth and follow Him, the man walks away sad. This Gospel is not about condemning wealth but about highlighting how worldly attachments can prevent us from following God fully.

Wealth, in itself, is not wrong. The Church teaches that material goods are gifts from God, entrusted to us for the good of others (Catechism of the Catholic Church #2401-2406). We are called to be stewards, using our resources to serve our families and support those in need. Wealth can be a great blessing when used in service to others.

The real issue is attachment—when something becomes so important to us that it takes the place of God. This can happen with wealth, but also with other things: sports, entertainment, or even family activities that leave no room for God. We all have our own "wealth" that we may find difficult to let go of for the sake of serving God.

Jesus' conversation with the young man reminds us to ask ourselves: what attachments are holding us back? The disciples worried that it seemed impossible to enter the Kingdom of Heaven, but Jesus reassured them, saying, "With God, all things are possible." God's grace can help us overcome our attachments and fully commit to His mission.

Let's pray for the grace to see our blessings as gifts to be shared and to trust that with God's help, we can put Him first in our lives. If we surrender our attachments and live generously, we will find joy in serving both God and others.
