From the Pastor



One of the traditions here at St. Mary of the Assumption Parish that we are most proud of is the Patriotic Rosary before the 4th of July. It was partnered with Incarnation Parish shortly after we purchased our Yankee Road property years before we actually built our church. Many will remember that it was on the other side of the ponds on Springs Boulevard. I remember telling people to use your imagination and see a church on the other side of the ponds some day. We said the rosary with the church actually being built the month before the Dedication. The year that we opened we said the rosary on our back patio looking at the ponds from the other side.

Once we regionalized with St. Augustine Parish, we invited their parishioners into the partnership. Parishioners from St. Mary of the Assumption, Incarnation, and St. Augustine parishes praying and working together to build the Kingdom of God on the south side of Dayton. Two years ago we shared refreshments after we prayed together. In the midst of the pandemic last summer, it was scheduled on the patio with social distancing, but because of heat was moved inside. Since the 4th of July is on a Sunday this year, we will be having our Patriotic Rosary Friday evening, July 2, at 7:00 around our new Marian Garden. As we did in the beginning of this tradition, we encourage people to bring their lawn chairs or just sit on the ground as many originally did. There will be chairs provided but may not be as comfortable as lawn chairs. Refreshments will be provided and served by our Knights of Columbus and Ladies Society. In the midst of all the political division in the nation at present, let's gather together to pray for the health of the nation. As Archbishop Schnurr did last weekend to end the Marian Pilgrimage on the occasion of the Bicentennial anniversary of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, "let's rededicate ourselves to Jesus through Mary."

small group. Jr High will meet on Wednesdays from 5:30-7:30pm. High School will meet on Sundays



Planned Giving Committee Tax Items

As the 2021 year continues to progress, there are numerous tax law changes which could impact you and your family due to the American rescue plan act of 2021.

In 2020, the IRS allowed individuals who claim the standard deduction to claim a \$300 "Above the Line" deduction for donation to qualified charities. For 2021, this deduction is enhanced to allow a \$600 deduction for a couple filing Married filing jointly who claim the standard deduction.

Parishioners with children may also notice an immediate impact from the child tax credit. The credit allows qualifying dependents a credit of up to \$3,000 per child (\$3,500 for children under 6) subject to certain phase out limitations. The IRS has been instructed to estimate taxpayers' expected credit and pay monthly advances of the annual estimated amount. These advance payments will be remitted from July through December 2021 and taxpayers will be required to reconcile the credit on their 2021 tax returns. Taxpayers do have an option to "opt-out" of the advanced payments.

The American Rescue Plan Act provided an additional stimulus payment in 2021. If you did not qualify in 2020 but do qualify in 2021, you will be entitled to claim the stimulus payment when you file your 2021 tax return.

Finally, for parishioners receiving retirement income, the required minimum distribution (RMD) is the minimum amount you must withdraw from your IRA, Sep IRA, simple IRA, or retirement plan account when you reach age 72. The Cares Act allows seniors to skip RMD's altogether in 2020 without penalty; however, in 2021, the RMD is once again required.

St. Mary's does not intend to provide tax advice with this message. Please consult your tax advisor for additional detail and how tax legislation may impact you individually.
