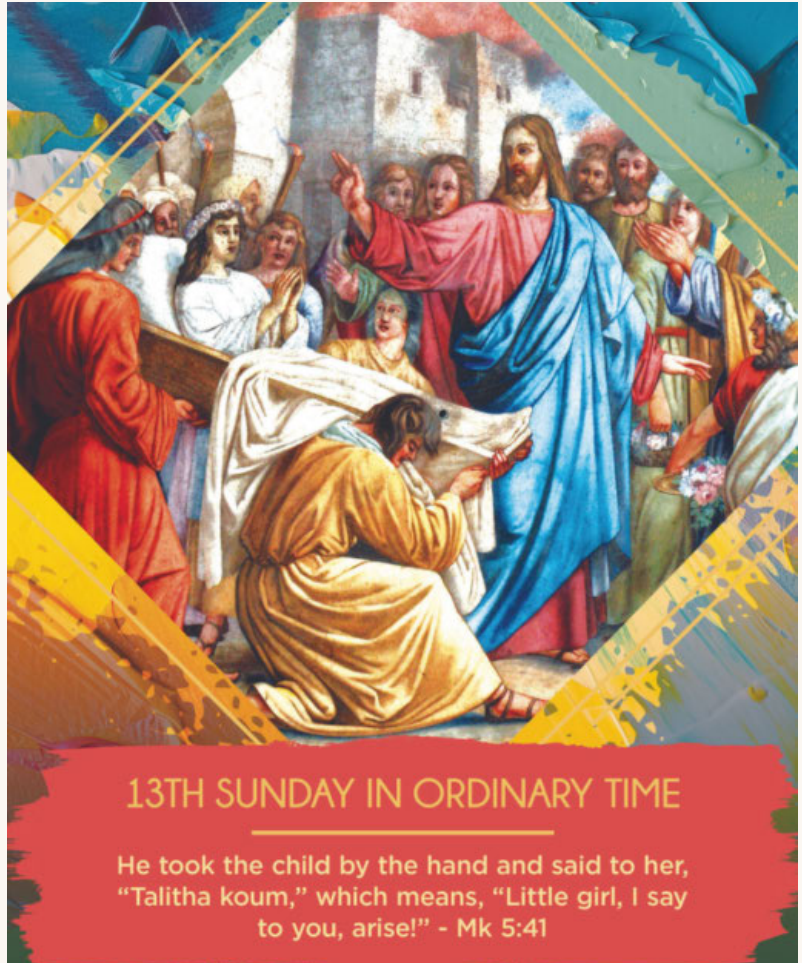

As we embark into our 2025 fiscal year, I am filled with gratitude for the light and dedication that each of you brings to our parish family. Last week in our bulletin insert, we outlined several initiatives that will enhance both the functionality and aesthetics of our parish campuses. These summer projects include (in no particular order):

- **Parking lot repairs:** Parking lot repairs need to be done at all three campuses. At St. Mary of the Assumption- the lot will need to be repaired to allow for proper water drainage and resurfaced. At Our Lady of Good Hope the lot will be milled, and repaved. At St. Henry the lot will be milled, repaved, and have appropriate curb work completed.
- **Painting in the Our Lady of Good Hope St. Joseph Center:** The main hallways, meeting room, and choir room will all get a fresh coat of paint, and any needed repairs on the walls.
- **Landscaping updates at St. Henry:** The many beds at St. Henry will be treated, and a landscaping company will be looking into the best path forward for us to replant and maintain these beds. **To that end- if there is something that you hold close that is currently planted in these beds, we ask that you reach out to us to make a plan to obtain the bulbs or plants before July 1.**
- **Fencing at Our Lady of Good Hope:** New fencing will be installed surrounding the perimeter of the parking lot at Our Lady of Good Hope and the green space that faces Third Street.
- **Parish Activity Center Renovations at St. Henry:** Our PAC will receive a new gym floor. The surface will serve as a safe, multipurpose floor for all groups to use within our parish family. The facility will also get new paint, upgraded technology in meeting spaces, cosmetic enhancements in the main entry, upgraded stage features (light and sound), and updated kitchen equipment.
- **Playscape at Our Lady of Good Hope:** The green space that faces Third Street at Our Lady of Good Hope will be expanded to include a naturescape. This space will be utilized by all youth in our parish family - including our PSR students, and students at Bishop Leibold School.
- **St. Mary Parish Center Enhancements:** In the St. Mary Parish Center Kitchen appliance upgrades will be completed. In addition, classrooms will be reimagined to be more fully utilized for meetings such as grief ministry, faith formation group meetings, and more. Classrooms will be outfitted with soft seating, tables, and more.

As we move forward with these plans, I invite each of you to join us in prayerful consideration of how you might support this important initiative. If you would like information on how you can financially support these projects, and future projects please reach out to me. I will be happy to meet with you.

We appreciate your continued patience as we do know that our facilities will be slightly disrupted during this time. Please know that we have done our best to coordinate the timing to impact scheduled events as minimally as possible. Together, we can continue to build a church that not only meets the needs of our current congregation but also reaches out to those in our community who are searching for faith, hope, and belonging. Be on the lookout for progress reports for all of these items that we will publish in mid-July, early August, and late August!
