BAPTISM: Please call the parish office to make arrangements. Baptism is administered after Mass on Sundays. Those desiring other times may make special arrangements. Attendance at Baptismal Instructions is required before the Sacrament is administered.

MARRIAGE: Arrangements should be made at least 6 months in advance. Attendance at Pre-Cana Conferences is required.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION: Both Parishes - 30 minutes before daily Mass.

Saturday - Holy Spirit - North Collins; Before and After 5:30 p.m. Mass. Others by Appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK: Please notify the parish office of the seriously ill or aged who are confined to their homes so that they might receive the Anointing of the Sick.

SACRAMENT OF HOLY EUCHARIST: We gladly bring this sacrament to the sick or shut-ins. Please notify us.

"PLEASE REMEMBER IMMACULATE CONCEPTION PARISH IN YOUR WILL"

**REQUIREMENTS FOR
GODPARENTS AND WITNESSES
AT A CATHOLIC BAPTISM CEREMONY**

1. Must be at least 16 years of age.
2. Must be a baptized Catholic who has completed the sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation, in good standing with the Church (a letter of recommendation from his/her parish is needed).
3. If married, must be married in the Catholic Church, regularly attending Mass on Sunday, and living his/her faith.
4. Church law only requires for a Catholic baptism to have at least one godparent; however, it has been tradition to have two.
5. If you choose only one godparent, you are free to choose a male or a female. However, if you wish to have two godparents, there must be one male and one female.
6. A baptized, non-Catholic may serve as an "official witness" to the baptism, only if there is a proper Catholic sponsor who fully meets all requirements of a godparent. The non-Catholic who is selected as a witness should be an active and participating member of his/her church community. During the baptism, a non-Catholic witness may perform all the parts of the ceremony that a godparent does.
7. Canon Law describes a witness as: "A baptized person who belongs to a non-Catholic ecclesial community." An official witness doesn't need a letter of recommendation from his/her church.
8. Non-baptized persons may not serve as witnesses or godparents.
9. If a godparent cannot attend the baptism ceremony, a proxy can stand in the place of the missing godparent. The name of that person will be entered as "proxy" in the Sacramental Record Book (and Baptismal Certificate), along with the name of the missing godparent. It means for a Catholic baptism ceremony there must be at least one godparent or his/her proxy plus one baptized, non-Catholic as an official witness.

**POPE PROCLAIMS
YEAR OF FAMILIES**

On March 19, 2021, the Church celebrates the fifth anniversary of the publication of Pope Francis's apostolic exhortation *Amoris Laetitia*, on the beauty and joy of love in the family. On this same day, Pope Francis will launch the year "Amoris Laetitia Family," which will conclude on June 26, 2022, during the 10th Meeting of Families in Rome with the Holy Father.

Pope Francis announced the year of "Amoris Laetitia Family" during his Angelus Message on the Feast of the Holy Family on December 27, 2020. He ended his address invoking the Blessed Mother: "May the Virgin Mary grant that families throughout the world be increasingly fascinated by the evangelical ideal of the Holy Family, so as to become a leaven of [a] new humanity and of a genuine and universal solidarity."
